PM for DoD Projects and PMP certification articulate the level of skill and talent required of the profession. 	<p><u>Curriculum Overview</u></p> <p>This course focuses on the application of project management principles, as promulgated by the Project Management Institute (PMI), in the planning and execution of DoD projects. The course will prepare members of the project delivery teams, from both the private and public sectors, to work together efficiently by utilizing a common set of project terms and principles as they are applied by the engineering agencies of the uniformed services. The intent is for DoD Program and Project Managers and their supporting contractors and consultants to learn how, side-by-side in an academic environment, to apply DoD project management to the successful execution of programs and projects.</p> <p>The course is based on the Fourth Edition of the Project Management Body of Knowledge (PMBOK) Guide that went into effect on January 1, 2009. The nine functional areas and their processes of the PMBOK Guide will be followed in the sequence of application within the project life cycle. The PMBOK is supplemented by extensions developed for the Design, Procurement Construction (DPC) community and for the Defense Industry. The course also addresses the project management standards of practice and business principles adopted by DoD engineering agencies and reflects their consistency with the PMBOK. A little known fact is that the PMBOK had its genesis in the work of the former Defense Systems Management College.</p> <p>In addition, the course will cover the pre-requisite training needed to study for the Project Management Professional (PMP) Certification Exam offered by the Project Management Institute For the beginner, this course will lay the groundwork for the considerable preparation required for taking the PMP Exam; for those presently trained in the PMBOK and eligible to complete the certification requirements, it serves as refresher prior to sitting for the PMP exam.</p> <p><u>Instructor Biography</u></p> <p>Ahmet Taspinar, MBA, PMP, REP MacDonald-Bedford LLC Mr. Taspinar, a civil engineer, certified PMP, and a PMI Registered Educational Provider (REP) with 40 years of experience in managing energy and Information systems projects, is the Director of Training Services for MacDonald-Bedford LLC.
