The board discussed the 2013 budget.

- The Fisher house line just reflects collections through Event Brite
- The Yellow Ribbon budget doesn't roll over. It is a budget item although all income reflects donations.
- Event Brite Fees are not broken out by event, just listed as an expense
- In the past we had budgeted \$1500 for lunches but are losses are greater now so it has been rounded up to \$2500 per year.
- The cost of our annual audit has increased
- Jeff- Adjusted lines for lunches to reflect actual expenses, about a \$750 loss total maximum.
- All other 2013 lines in budget the same as 2012.
