1. President's Corner (Ken Stegall)

Programs (Ms. Nichole Lashley/ Ms. Nadja Turek/Mr. Jeff Leonard)
The agenda for next Post luncheon (09 Jan) was discussed, see attached.

- The February luncheon was then discussed. This luncheon will be a joint meeting the American Society of Civil Engineers and will occur on 20 Jan 14 at the Twin Base Clubhouse.
- It was announced that the March speaker is planned to be Mr. Joe Sciabeca, Director of the Air Force Civil Engineer Center.
- Jeff then led a discussion on luncheon fee structure. Previously, the board tasked Jeff to propose a new fee structure to ensure that the Post will breaks-even on future monthly luncheons.
