Mark Kessinger is the Federal Business Coordinator for DLZ National. He started with DLZ in 2015 after a 33-year career with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

During his career at the Corps he managed a wide range of water resources projects including the design and construction of dams, locks, floodwalls and ecosystem restoration projects. He also was the project manager for dismantling NASA's only nuclear reactor in Sandusky, Ohio, and leading a team of dam safety experts who evaluated the structural integrity of Buckeye Lake Dam for the Ohio Department of Natural Resources.

He also served as the Corps's Liaison to the State of Ohio and the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District so he was heavily involved in water resource issues affecting Ohio.

He graduated from West Virginia University with a BS in Civil Engineering and earned a Master's degree in Engineering Management from Marshall University. He is a SAME Fellow, an avid college football fan, and he and his wife, Renee, are actively trying to raise twin 19-year-old sons.
