Jacob King is the Fire Chief at Wright Patterson Air Force Base, one of the largest in the world, and is responsible for responding to emergencies involving structural fires, aircraft emergencies, hazardous materials spill, and leaks, confined space rescues, weapons of mass destruction emergencies, natural

disasters and medical emergencies. Wright Patterson AFB is also one of the largest military communities in the world, covering 8,145 acres with a daily population of over 50,000. The fire department is responsible for providing coverage for 3,490 buildings and housing units, with assets and aircraft valued at over 1.5 trillion dollars. As incident commander, Chief King responds to fire and hazardous material emergencies, while managing a department of 91 personnel and three fire stations. He ensures all firefighters meet or exceed the training and certification requirements of the Air Force, the Department of Defense, and the National Fire Protection Association.
