## **Awards Task Force**

The Task Force has requested more time to truly evaluate the SAME Awards & Recognition system due to the lack of response from the Board. They received five responses from the board with their initial proposal.

Action: They will send out another e-mail end of June; Board members should respond before the end of July. Final recommendations will be presented at the Fall Board Meeting (Encl 2).

## **BOD Recognition Pin**

The Board approved the creation and purchase of some type of recognition for serving on the Board of Direction. The Board was solicited with options and settled on a pin that would serve as recognition and as an identifier to members in order to spark conversation and participation. The pin was delivered to JETC and will be brought to SBC for any Board members that missed getting one.

- Eight actions were presented to the Board for discussion. The Board voted to refine the actions via email. After the meeting, discussion points were consolidated and sent to the Board for discussion and vote. The document (Encl 3) received a majority vote on 6-20-17.

## **New Business**

### **Membership Streamer**

There was motion to eliminate the membership streamer as part of the discussion about Sponsorship. Some felt that eliminating the pressure involved in getting the membership streamer would allow Posts to feel better about sharing members in reference to sponsorship and scholarships; this would not eliminate the necessity of providing membership numbers to evaluate Society health. Others felt that the streamer requirement has already been minimized enough over the years and eliminating it would send a negative message to Posts; it would also eliminate the positive action that some Posts take to call members individually to update their memberships.

Action: After some discussion, a motion was made to establish a Task Force to evaluate the streamer and make recommendations to the Board.

### **Membership Cost Structure**

There was a motion for the National Office to evaluate the individual membership dues structure to make it more equitable and consistent—specifically uniformed and civilian government employee rates.

Action: The National Office will evaluate the dues structure and provide a business case for any recommended restructuring.

#### **Executive Director Contract Extension**

SAME National Staff left the room while the Board had a short discussion on extending the contract for the SAME National Executive Director. The contract extension was approved.

Meeting was adjourned at 1700 hrs.

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## Goals

- Align the awards and recognition program with the 2020 Strategic Plan
- · Streamline submittal process
- Capture the work that is being done at the Post level and leverage HQ to facilitate national recognition.
- · Improved communication at the Post level
  - Posts with similar awards can easily recognize their awardees in the national program

## **Comments from BOD members**

- Concur with highlighting the individuals who contribute at a national level in TME
- I really like the idea of a post level award being submitted to the National Level for consideration. This was we should see the best from across all of SAME
- Concur with both the mentoring and STEM awards aligned with our strategic direction.

#### ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

- Name of the awards. I recommend keeping the Names of the awards and using the description to highlight what the award is for. Strengthens our history & heritage
- Unclear if you agreed with the recommendation to have all regions submit nominations for all
  awards. I like the concept (sets an expectation for leadership in the regions), but I think it should
  not be forced. Standard should be that regions must consider nominating someone for each award
- SAME Mentoring award@concur with the nomination supported by a post president or a member
  of the national board of direction, but I¹m not clear why you also insist on a Fellow nomination
  (could reserve that for the (Gerald C. Brown Mentoring award)
- · Post Service Award conçur with expanding to one for small, med and large posts
- STEM Outreach Award and STEM Outreach Advocate Award: Not sure why two awards. First is for small, med and large posts looks the most appropriate
- For the organizational awards, concur with the universal change/clarification (FOR EMINENT CONTRIBUTIONS TO EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS, DISASTER RELIEF, AND NATIONAL SECURITY)

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## **Comments from BOD members**

- · Recognition of Outstanding Young Members (under 40)- recommend one per region, not the 5 indicated.
- All awards
  - a. Concur in broadening criteria to be emergency preparedness, disaster relief and national security.
  - b. Concur with all electronic submittal.
  - c. Concur that post, regional and national nominations be on the same template for ease of review at all levels.
- Mentoring Award- non-concur with recommendation to create another award in addition to the Gerald C.
   Brown Mentoring Award. If we need to modify the eligibility to simply add SAME member that is ok, but we don't need two awards for the same objective.
- Deletion of Technology Advancement Medal and Replacement by STEM outreach medals- three for posts
  and one individual. Concur. Just remember this in a few years when we see STEM as no longer the focus
  we do now.
- Post Service Medal. Non concur with the recommended number of awards; too many if we have one for each size post (SML) and then one per region (or is it one per post size-3- for each region?) Recommend one medal per region annually.

## **Comments from BOD members**

- Why do we need to have multiple awards for mentorship? Why do we have one specifically for fellows, and one for non-fellows? Aren't Fellows by their definition are supposed to be the hallmark, the definition, the Gold Standard, for mentoring?
- Disagree with desire to delete the Technology Advancement Medal. As a former Program Manager and project manager for several multi-billion dollar programs, we could not have brought them in without the innovative thinking of our private sector and federal sector team members. We want to encourage and recognize a culture of innovation. I disagree that scopes and criteria do not support innovative thinking and creativity. This award needs to stay, and be highlighted, now more than ever. Innovation will help the three services stretch their limited resources to meet their missions and achieve the capability they need.
- If we are getting poor or a lack of submissions, I suggest that we need to increase our advertising efforts for this recognition opportunity.

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## **Comments from BOD members**

- SAME Mentoring Award (New Award): I think the intent of this award is good, but I don't know if we really need
  it. The candidate pool seems small as I would think many of the people engaging in all these wonderful facets of
  mentorship are probably SAME Fellows. If you do proceed with the new award, I wouldn't include the SAME
  Fellow endorsement requirement along with the Post Post President and National Board Member. Seems like
  another step that will just lead to fewer nominations.
- Paul R. Smith NCO Medal: I recommend changing the name to "Paul R. Smith Enlisted Medal", and change the eligibility to "Any Active, Reserve, National Guard or Retired Enlisted Member® In the YMC, we've made a concerted effort to increase enlisted membership, even standing up a YMC Enlisted Committee this year. When we did that, the founders asked that we use <sup>3</sup>Enlisted<sup>2</sup> instead of "NCO" because it encompasses the full range of enlisted members, as opposed to "NCOs" who only represent a subset of enlisted members. If we want to push SAME as a career-long professional Society for enlisted members, it needs to start before they're NCOs and include SNCOs and Chiefs as well. I don't think anyone ever intended on excluding groups of enlisted members when using the term "NCO" but I support trying our best to be as deliberately inclusive as possible.
- Post Service Medal: I don't understand what you're trying to do with this Medal. Are you recommending we
  award ~20 total awards each year? I agree with removing the Distinguished Post criteria, but think the other
  recommended changes dilute the value of the medal. You could potentially award one for each level of Post since
  it's tough for someone to have the same level of accomplishment at a small post as a large post, but RVPs can give
  out RVP medals for the regional top performers.

## **Comments from BOD members**

#### Cont'd

- Tech Advancement Medal: Agree 100% with deleting the award.
- YM Medal: Minor change Instead o "Officer and NCO" for the military medal title, recommend calling
  it "Uniformed Service" on need to distinguish between officer and enlisted Yms.
- STEM Outreach Post: Admin note@he eligibility criteria is for the individual award and does not apply to
  posts. More substantively, don't we already recognize STEM accomplishments for Posts in the streamer
  process?
- STEM Outreach Individual: I'm in favor of creating this award. However, I would start with just one award
  total. If you get a lot of nominations, perhaps you could consider S/M/L winners in the future. But we have
  enough trouble getting nominations for the awards we already have.
- Organizational Medals: I'm confused with how you've changed the focus of these three medals. You've changed the description to more of a focus on specific contributions to emergency prep, disaster relief, and national security, but in the criteria section you say the overall intent is to identify best practices with SAME membership. Are these awards supposed to be for contributions to SAME or contributions to the profession in line with the SAME Strategic Plan? I think it's confusing as written and may just lead to even fewer nominations to already poorly nominated awards. I don't know how valuable the organizational awards are to our Sustaining Members, but with maybe one or two nominations each year, perhaps we should consider doing away with them altogether?

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# **Recommendations for BOD**

- · All awards submitted electronically
- Similar awards at Post Level can be submitted for similar National Award. Must meet criteria.
- Mentor Award is given to both Fellow and Non-Fellow. Same Criteria
- Gerald C. Brown Mentoring Award. Modify Eligibility to include non-fellows. Do not create another award.
- Paul R. Smith NCO Medal: Change the name to "Paul R. Smith Enlisted Medal", and change the eligibility to "Any Active, Reserve, National Guard or Retired Enlisted Member.
- Post Service Medal: Delete "Distinguished Post " from eligibility. Recommend one medal per region annually.
- Technology Award: Deletion of Technology Advancement Medal and Replacement by STEM outreach
  medals- three for posts and one individual. Just remember this in a few years when we see STEM as no
  longer the focus we do now.
- STEM Outreach Individual: Start with just one award. Look at participation and determine whether increasing recipients to Small , Medium, Large
- · Make these changes effective now for 2017 submissions. We will keep working on the rest.

#### **Proposed Actions to Board of Direction**

from 5-22-17 meeting

#### **Proposed Actions:**

- Update and implement the Military and Government Member National Recruiting Program in order to bring back our core membership.
  - a. Identify "touch points" throughout careers.
    - i. add commander's courses.
    - ii. add enlisted courses.
  - b. Add USMC.
  - c. Identify champions for the Academies/National Targets
  - d. Establish working group led by Vice President to continue momentum, enhance and coordinate efforts with National Office, Leaders, RVPs and Post Leaders.
  - e. Re-institute Enlisted/NCO Council.
- Develop a National Standard of Life-Long Support through Recruiting, Retention, and Scholarships, to demonstrate care for members in order to set SAME apart.
  - a. This standard should utilize all members of the Society and not only focus on Fellows.
  - b. It should be a three-pronged approach:
    - i. Student to member.
    - ii. Member to Grave (i.e. the sponsorship does not stop with membership, but may take on a slightly different flavor).
    - iii. Military to industry.
  - Develop a National Scholarship standard that tracks scholarship recipients after the acceptance of scholarship.
- Fully implement the Post-level Industry-Government Engagement plan (Post Issues Workshops) in order to enhance SAME contributions to solving infrastructure related challenges.
  - a. Update the National Industry-Government Engagement plan with better focus on how Streamer Requirements fit in the plan. Reference Relationship Streamer – Required #4: Provide report on the results of issues workshops to National.
  - b. Include training on Post Issues Workshops in Post Leadership Workshops.
  - c. Provide an on-line tool-box or resource site for Posts and Regions to conduct Issues Workshops.
- 4. Implement the Volunteer Management and Best Practices training provided by the new Post Leaders Workshop in order to support the membership recruiting, retention and participation efforts.
  - a. Provide a PLW training guidance product for Post Leaders to take back to Posts.
  - b. Require PLW attendees to back-brief respective Posts.
  - c. Consider National sponsorship of "at large" members and "transit military" members.
  - d. Establish a Post Leaders opportunity at Regional and/or National Conferences.
- 5. Push communications from posts to national to expand "Society News" and celebrate volunteers.
  - a. SAME will enable more Society News to be sent from Posts "upward" by using a targeted solicitation within a quarterly outreach to Post Leaders in order to better celebrate volunteers, spread best practices and highlight member participation for the purposes of greater functionality as One Society.
  - b. Suggested enablers include:
    - i. Establishing a Post Communication Chair/Director (mandatory) to manage the effort.
    - ii. Develop 1-page "how-to" with guidance and suggested topics; "Prime the pump" by soliciting input from specific subset of posts each publication period to develop confidence in participants and nurture desired results. Consider developing a

questionnaire that targeted Post can complete and that could be used in spotlighting Post in TME article/column. Brainstorm themes to assist Posts in providing relevant input (E-Week, Campers, Industry Day, Alternate Credit activities).

- 6. Post Annual Reports remain mandatory and will now accurately celebrate the volunteer work of our members.
  - a. Incentivize and encourage Posts to submit for streamers.
  - b. Add slot to Annual Report that enables Posts that do not submit for streamers to still elaborate on what they have done as a Post. This mechanism ought to serve as surrogate and/or supplement to Streamer Submission. Be sure to involve photo submissions.
- RVPs complete assessments of posts, field chapters and student chapters by November 2017 and recommend actions to the BOD.
  - a. Send additional data on assessment factors.
- 8. Establish the <u>Centennial Planning TF</u> in order to begin planning the SAME Centennial Celebration, reimagine JETC 2020, and make recommendations to the BOD.
  - Clarify that this TF is established to celebrate the Society's Centennial which includes JETC (i.e. there may be other opportunities through media and at local levels to celebrate in addition to main focus of JETC).
  - b. Create a toolbox of ways that Posts and Regions can celebrate the Centennial.
  - c. TME Issues throughout the year on Past 100 and Future Path.
  - d. To gain more attendees and exhibitors, enlarge the focus to include non-military/non-federal government agencies who also support national defense/natural disaster and national infrastructure.
  - e. Include member on the TF with marketing/event planning experience.

#### Implementation:

Once approved by the Board of Direction, the BOD holds the Society accountable for fully implementing the actions. The overall benefit of this approach is to achieve *unity of effort* across the Society while enabling and building on the local goodness of Posts.
