

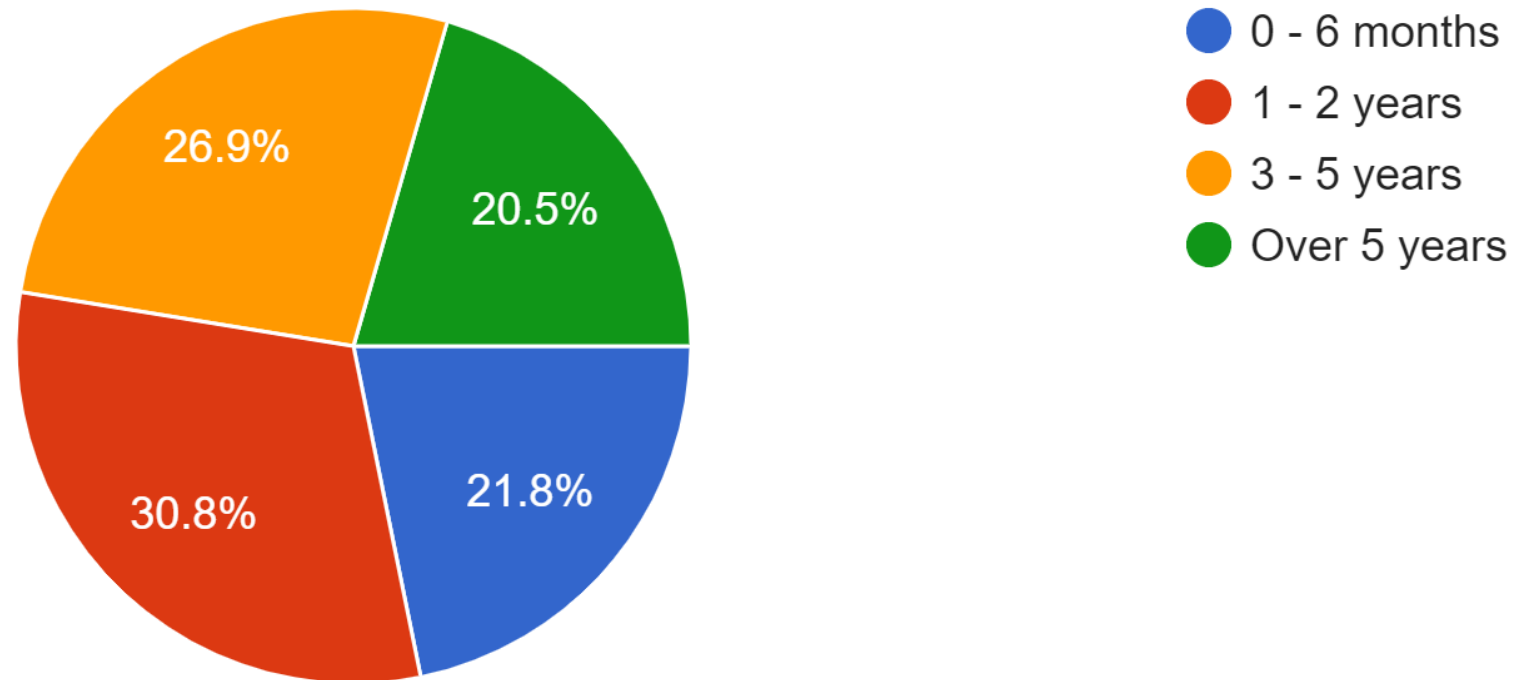

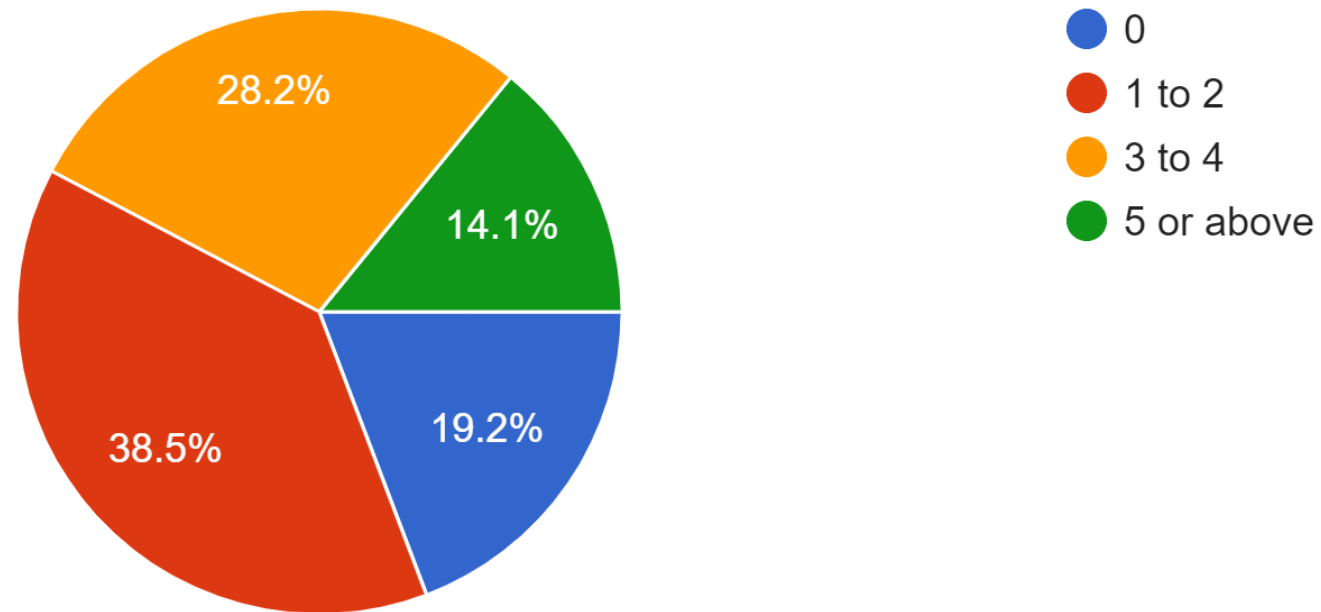
1. How long have you been a member of the ECOI?
