REQUIREMENTS

The Certified Professional Services Manager (CPSM) credential is offered by the Society for Marketing Professional Services (SMPS).

- Possess a bachelor's degree or an advanced degree, plus four years of experience in marketing or business development for firms providing professional services;
- Possess an associate degree, plus six years of experience in marketing or business development for firms providing professional services; or
- Without a degree, have eight years of experience in marketing or business development for firms providing professional services.
- Pledge to abide by the CPSM Code of Ethics.
- Complete and submit the online CPSM application form and application fee to Professional Testing Corporation. Include a copy of your college transcript or a notarized photocopy of your degree (when applicable).
- The application will be reviewed, and candidates will receive their Scheduling Authorization from Prometric Testing Center.

TEST FORMAT

The CPSM examination consists of 150 4-option, multiple choice questions that were developed in accordance with the SMPS Domains of Practice.
