


Fostering an Inclusive Climate

Two Distinct Set of Experiences for an Inclusive Climate

A climate is inclusive when its norms are carefully constructed to promote experiences of both belonging and uniqueness for its members.

- Belongingness
- Your uniqueness is valued and integrated





Experiences and States

Belongingness - feeling that you are a valued member of the in-group.



Uniqueness is valued and integrated – feeling that your unique identity is being recognized, no matter what school you attended or neighborhood you grew up in.
