



small business certification

King County's small business certification is called **Small Contractors and Suppliers (SCS)** and provides contracting incentives for the inclusion of small business on County contracts.

SCS Contracting Incentives for King County Funded Good & Services Contracts:

- ✓ Purchases between \$10,000 and \$50,000: Requires quotes from three companies with at least one quote from an SCS firm.
- ✓ Purchases \$50,000+: A Fair Market Range Percentage Incentive is used to provide opportunities for small businesses to be competitive on low bid procurements.
- ✓ SCS goals applied to Requests for Proposals.
- ✓ SCS Accelerator set aside program for consulting services procurements.

small business certification

SCS Contracting Incentives for King County Funded Construction and Architectural & Engineering contracts:

- ✓ Percentage of the total contract amount required to go to SCS certified firms on consultant and construction contracts.
- ✓ Architectural/Engineering Roster requires solicitation of proposals from SCS certified firms 60% of AE roster contracts have been awarded to SCS certified firms.

SCS certification is recognized by:









SCS eligibility criteria:

Owner's Personal net worth less than \$1.32M

Three-year average gross receipts meet Small Business Administration business size standards

pro-equity contracting - fast-track SCS certification

- ✓ State certified minority- and womenowned businesses automatically qualify for SCS certification.
- ✓ Diversifies and expands SCS pool and increases eligibility of BIPOC- and women- owned firms for SCS incentives.
- ✓ No SCS application required.
- ✓ Email <u>scscertification@kingcounty.gov</u> to opt in.



pro-equity contracting - ESJ innovation

King County's Equity and Social Justice (ESJ) Innovation Plan

- ✓ Applies to King County funded AEP and Technical Consulting procurements
- ✓ Proposer assigns aspirational M/WBE goals and submits an outreach plan
- ✓ Proposer is scored on quality of outreach plan and specific actions taken to maximize M/WBE participation.
- ✓ M/WBE firms must be certified by the Washington State OMWBE office
- ✓ Additional Equity goals may be applied




