#1 Industry Government Engagement

Key Outcome: SAME provides thought leadership that directly brings awareness to key IGE issues and solutions

 Defense Authorization Act, VA and SBA – certifying VOSB, Project Partnering, Cost Estimating, TORN, Process, Alternative Delivery Method, Climate Change: Sea Level Rise in Coastal Regions, Cybersecurity, PFAS

IGE Program Management provides a *deliberate, consistent, repeatable, & transparent* process to manage national-level IGE efforts ensuring we deliver impact and maximize use of available resources in the service of our National Security

#1 Industry Government Engagement

- Defense Authorization Act, VA and SBA
 - Initiated in 2017 by Charleston Post
 - Competing process for obtaining certification
 - Law has Changed and Implementation rules being developed

New IGE Topics being Validated and Approved by the Executive Committee

Ramp Up Act – Small Business Standard

- Transitional period for firms in the 236220 and 54130 NAICS Codes
- Pilot moratorium program that will provide capacity to execute federal projects
- Prospective SBs will have a greater incentive to enter the federal market knowing they can sustainably grow their businesses.

Ramp Up Act – Small Business Standard

- SBs in the early stages of growth will no longer compete with larger small businesses for the smallest segment of awards, providing greater
- As the number of capable firms increase for larger awards, the government will begin to designate larger set-aside awards to SBs, following the Rule of Two. Thus, the government would have a greater qualified pool to meet its increasing SB goals
- The federal government will not only benefit from increased competition among those competing for larger SB set-aside awards, this shifts the risk away from the Government

Diversity, Equity, And Inclusion (DEI)

Key Outcome: SAME helps to initiative conversation and direct efforts that will increase the diversity of all types in the A/E/C profession and within our membership.

- Led through a Working Group in the Membership COI
- Improving DEI at all levels of leadership in our Society
- Focusing on efforts to increase overall diversity of thought in the A/E/C profession in supporting national security

Key Leader Development Commission

Key Outcome: Continue the KLDC and its efforts to widen the Society's pool of leadership candidates through identification, mentoring, nurturing, encouragement, opportunities, and recognition.

- Led by Col Matt Altman, PE, S.FAME, since established in 2017
- Build up SAME's leadership pipeline and ensure it more fully represents the membership base in all aspects

STEM Outreach to American Indian/Alaska Native Youth

- Goal Number 4: "Enrich the STEM Pipeline for the Nation."
- AI/AN community leaders to determine STEM needs in the community
- Anchorage, AK; Minot, ND; Albuquerque, NM; and Panama City, FL
- Meaningful STEM engagement by SAME's 102 Posts with the over 500 federally-recognized tribes.
