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FSRM-Installation Support-Take-A-Ways

- ► USACE is placing emphasis on "SRM" execution to support both Army and AF for "O&M" funded renovations and repairs.
- ▶ Omaha has established an SRM execution team with PM's "forward" (Ft Carson, USAFA, and Denver) as well in Omaha. Also, a dedicated Contract team located in Co Springs.
- Omaha has tailored "SRM" processes and contracts.

Facility Sustainment, Restoration and Modernization (FSRM)

Definition:

Support of operations, maintenance, and facility repair of military installations and reimbursable work from DOD Agencies

Locations/Customers:

- Military Installations/customers in Omaha AOR
 - Colorado: Ft Carson; Peterson AFB; Buckley AFB; AF Academy; Schreiver AFB; Cheyenne Mt.
 - South/North Dakota/ Wyoming: Ellsworth AFB; Minot AFB; Grand Forks AFB; F.E. Warren AFB;
 - Nebraska: Offutt AFB
 - Wisconsin: Ft. McCoy



Why USACE?

- More technically complex projects
- In House Engineering reachback
- Contracting Execution Tools (AE, Construction)
- Construction Management
- End of FY capacities
- Heaviest SRM workload: Fort Carson, USAFA, Peterson AFB, and Minot AFB

DoD utilizing O&M funding

- Installations are being more creative on usage of "O&M" funding.
- Increasing major renovation projects >\$10M
- AF/Army utilizing 2 year programing cycle.
 (Year 1 –Design/Year 2- Construction)
- Industry issues: Advertise SAF/Straddle;
 Holding bids; No Contingency.

- MATOC: \$25M Hubzone D/B- TBD
- MATOC: \$135M 8(a) D/B- TBD
- \$49M Roofing: Estimated award 4th QTR FY 21.
- Potential Colorado SATOC \$8M (Via two \$4M 8(a) contracts) TBD.
- FY 23- Replacement of MATOCs (SB/SDVOB)



Other Acquisition Discussion:

- ► Omaha District will seek HQ approval to obtain \$500 M portfolio of contracts for FY 22-26.
- ► The portfolio will consist of previous acquisitions, all supporting Small Business
- ► Will be D/B and for entire Omaha Area (some will be front range focused)
- ► Will continue to utilize 8(a) direct awards
- ► Will continue RFP's for larger (\$>8M) projects

THE FUTURE - ARMY

Fort Carson:

➤ Omaha District will continue to support a portion of their \$30M annual O&M program for projects that are a good fit.

Includes: Roofing/Paving/Demolition

► IMCOM funded "larger" projects that are direct Army funded (Not part of FCN annual budget)

Fort McCoy:

► Infrastructure type projects.



THE FUTURE - AIR FORCE

- Larger/complicated (>\$5M) are a good fit for USACE.
- USAFA- Potential for major/large renovations.
- Minot AFB, Cavalier AFS
- Ellsworth AFB- Increasing MILCON and FSRM program
- Peterson AFB/Schriever AFB
- FE Warren AFB
