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



UNDERWAY AND EXISTING IDIQS

- Two Front Range MATOCS (\$49M Flatwork and Paving and \$49M Roofing Contract) Expect new roofing MATOC on the street November/December timeframe
- \$225M SB FSRM lots of capacity on this
- 2 x \$99M SDVOSB FSRM MATOC (these are under the \$560 FSRM Acquisition Plan and the second one is moving towards advertisement) a \$76M SDVOSB FSRM will be awarded in October timeframe
- \$80M 8(a) FSRM, DB/DBB IDIQ MATOC on hold until FY22 with existing MATOC capacity [NWO geography]

FRONT RANGE CONSTRUCTION CHALLENGES

- COVID-19!
- Booming economy and construction has created labor shortages that impact critical stages of construction
 Electrical, low voltage, drywall
- Mentoring for emerging small businesses (learning the USACE processes)
- Government design criteria convoluting application of building codes and draining stakeholder budgets
- Non-local prime contractors have challenges staffing key personnel and finding good subcontractors
- Schedule slippage and impact to stakeholders (Army, Air Force, others)
- Good contractors struggle with government procurement process, have difficulty "getting foot in the door"
- Balancing Quality, Safety, Schedule and delivering Full Scope






LESSONS LEARNED / SUGGESTIONS

- Provide a strong team that meets the requirements
- Send pre-bid questions. Don't wait for award and "hope" that the issue will be resolved after award
- Spend time and effort proof-reading proposals attention to detail
- Empower field staff to make decisions including those with financial impacts
- Demand regular evaluations from the USACE office that you are working for.
 - We have to provide interim CPARS (within 120 days of NTP) and at yearly intervals on our projects.
- Seek partnering opportunities and don't overlook partnering meeting at the beginning of the project.
- Embrace and utilize the proven USACE construction contract management tools and processes
- Seek resolution of issues at the field level where possible (lawyers don't solve our problems!)



COLLEGE GRADUATES WORKING FOR USACE

- USACE has direct hire authority for recent college graduates
- GS-5 (No Experience Required)
 - Recent graduates who have completed, within the previous two years, a qualifying engineering degree or certificate from a qualifying educational institution; OR current students who graduate no later than date listed.
- GS-7
 - Have one year of specialized experience related to Engineering. This definition of specialized experience is typical of work performed at the next lower grade/level position in the federal service; **OR** meet superior academic achievement with a GPA of 3.0.
