The IAE Systems

beta.SAM.gov

- beta.SAM.gov was launched in late 2017 as a consolidated location for all IAE systems.
- Other systems remain authoritative until their functionality, data, and roles are integrated into beta.SAM.gov and they are decommissioned.
- The term beta differentiates the consolidated site from SAM.gov.
- Once SAM is integrated into the consolidated system, it will be renamed SAM.gov, and beta will be retired.



 - description of all federal opportunity notices to include information on contracting office, summary description, any set aside or classification codes, and status

- Quick download of search results into PDF or CSV formats

Upcoming Improvements to Contract Opportunities

Agile Improvements Based on Feedback

We have heard you!

- A feedback mechanism on the site allows us to continually collect ideas about how to refine and improve the experience and rise up to meet user needs
- Since the November 2019 launch, the following improvements have been made:
 - Email Notifications for Saved Searches
 - Whenever saved search data is updated, the owner of the saved search receives an email. Emails sent are daily digests that alert user to a change.
 - Following List Now Shows Record ID (instead of the internal system identifier)
 - Users can now look at their Following page and more easily determine which opportunities they are following. Additional usability improvements are planned for future releases.

Planned Opportunities Improvements

Open Items	Details
Allow users to schedule searches	Allow users to set date and time for searches to run.
Public search to include filtering below sub-tier for opportunities	Filtering on search for Opportunities only by department down to office level (will not integrate filtering for other domains, and will not allow visibility of lower organization information)
Geographic capabilities	Allow users to select miles from designated locations.





Contract Data (FPDS) Reporting

New/Improved Capabilities


- Reports can now span 12 years instead of 5
- Reports can now return 150K rows instead of 30K
- Report structure can now be easily shared (attributes, metrics, etc)
- Additional reportable Data Fields
- Wizard like capability for report creation


• Transition Testing on beta.SAM.gov:

- Reports transition testing began on March 16, 2020. Transition period ongoing.
- Ad hoc reports converted and available for testing. Training options include: <u>videos</u>, <u>reference guides</u>, and <u>FAQs</u>.



Change Filters

- To see more filtering options select the 'change filters' on any search results page
- by selecting an item, the fitler will be added to the search page
- by removing an item, the filter will not show on the search page
- to show inactive items (i.e. 'very small business' as a set aside) toggle on the 'show inactive values




Contract Opportunity notice's have a new easy-to-review details page that shows clear view of changes, clear history for tracking changes.



Interested Vendors List

- If the Contracting Officer sets the notice to allow the IVL, a tab within the notice will show the IVL for logged in users with that permission
- Select 'Add' to have your entity show in the IVL
- If the contracting officer sets the IVL to allow vendors to see it, the list will show for users logged in with that permission






Follow

- By selecting 'follow' from the top of any display page, the user will now get emails for any updates made to the notice
- Select 'unfollow' to stop receiving the notices
- A user must be logged in to see this follow selection




Following Items

- From the 'workspace' select 'my followings'
- This is where users can manage their followings such as setting the frequency of emails and unfollow
- Selecting the Record ID link will take the user to the display page
- A user must be logged in to see this follow selection



Saved Searches

- From the 'workspace' select 'Saved Searches' or
- From any search results page select 'Saved Searches'
- This is where users can manage their saved searches, and rerun saved searches
- A user must be logged in to see this follow selection




Get Notifications via email

- From the 'saved searches' page select 'Actions' and then 'Notify'
- By selecting 'notify', the system will send an email at 9pm ET daily if new results were found that met the criteria of your search
- Select 'Stop notifying' to stop the email notifications
- A user must be logged in to see this follow selection

Data Services Extracts

Users can now download all Contract Opportunity data in an Excel spreadsheet from beta.SAM.gov.



Each domain has a folder with specific subfolders and files for that data set. Contract Opportunities has two main sub-folders:

- datagov: This is a CSV file with a full daily extract of all the public contract opportunities data. This is replaces the old FTP file.
- Buy American Act: This export is to provide transparency into reported federal awards that cited an exception to the Buy American Act.



Coming SOON: Contract Data (FPDS) Reporting

FPDS Reports are being retired

 FPDS Contract Data reports became available in the beta.SAM.gov Data Bank on March 16, 2020. On May 16, 2020, contract data report functionality will be decommissioned from FPDS.gov and will only be available on beta.SAM.gov.
 Contract Data reports will no longer be available on FPDS once the transition ends on May 16. Only the contract data reports functionality is transitioning; the rest of the functionality (search, agency data entry, data exports, etc.) will remain on FPDS.

• Static, Standard and Admin Reports are mostly the same

- Standard Reports now require login, but no role
- Ad Hoc Reports now have a "wizard" capability as well as a "build your own"
- Existing Ad Hoc reports in FPDS.gov conversion for beta.SAM.gov
 - Ad Hoc reports created by 1/31/2020 AND executed between 1/1/2019 and 1/31/2020 went through a conversion process resulting in 84% conversion

Sam.gov reports can be used to support analysis of federal spending including geographical analysis, market analysis, and analysis on the impact of the congressional and presidential initiatives in socio-economic areas such as small business spending. The data is also a reliable basis for measuring and assessing the impact of Federal acquisition policy and management improvement.

Contract Opportunities Reports

Reports on contract opportunities are available to the public. These reports provide detailed information in support of business decisions. As Agency Administrators with Contract Opportunity rights, you can access management reports to monitor published notices, attachments, and associated details.

This report provides authenticated Contract Opportunity Users with the ability to see all opportunities except for those in a draft status with all related public data, based on selected filters in a table/chart format.

There are no changes to the available Static Reports or any of their contents. The look of the page and the order of the categories are visual changes.






Standard and Administrative Reports

There are no changes in the standard or administrative reports that are available. However, the reports are now in alphabetical order in a list that displays 10 reports per page.







The functionality for standard and administrative reports is the same. There is a new interface, and a customized PDF export can provide a report with the appendix.





Standard and Administrative Reports

Users can still save criteria for standard and administrative reports. These are accessed from the reports list under the name of the report by clicking on *Saved Criteria*:





The basics of ad hoc reports are unchanged on beta.SAM.gov. Reports are still built from user-selected attributes, metrics, and filters. Instead of choosing from *Award-IDV Information* and *Other Transaction Information* while building the report, however, users now select which type of information to report on at the outset:



As with the previous system, the reports "home" displays all saved ad hoc reports. Unlike FPDS.gov, ad hoc reports in beta.SAM.gov are not grouped into folders. This functionality may be added in the future.






To create a new report, users click the red *Create* button. They can then either create a new blank report or use a report builder—a "wizard" that walks users through the steps of building an ad hoc report.




Creating a blank report is very similar to creating an ad hoc report in FPDS.gov. One difference is that users must specify a date range before adding attributes and metrics. The range of dates can now span 12 years.




To proceed after entering dates, click the *Edit in Design Mode* button in the lower left corner:





The same report-building options are available as in FPDS.gov, but are arranged differently. Metrics are found under the *Public Objects* folder on the left and attributes are found under *Schema Objects*. Attributes and metrics can be dragged from the list on the left into the appropriate areas for columns, rows, and metrics.





Filters are found above the report-building area in beta.SAM.gov. Attributes and metrics can be dragged from the area on the left into the Report Filter area. From there, users can select an operator and a value for the filter, either qualifying by a known value or selecting from a list of values.






After selecting the attributes, metrics, and filters, the report can be executed. In FPDS.gov, there was a button labeled *Execute*. In beta.SAM.gov, the *Run Report* button is the leftmost button (with the lightning bolt) in the menu of buttons above the working area on the left.





The executed report looks similar to the executed report in FPDS.gov.





Contract Opportunities

This site is the official source

Organizations within the federal government publish notices on proposed contract actions valued at more than \$25,000. These notices, or contract opportunities, cover announcements through official solicitations in the pre-award process. Anyone interested in doing business with the government can use this system to research active opportunities.

Each contract opportunity found here provides the following information:

- The original notice and any related notices to show the full pre-award acquisition
- A notice history that includes updates and tracking changes
- · Any related attachments or external links
- Instructions on how to submit a response, offer, or proposal
- The date on which responses are due

You can search for opportunities by keyword, solicitation ID, or by the name of a federal organization. You can then use a wide variety of filters to narrow results. Related notices are linked together to get a fuller acquisition view.

While you don't need a user account to view contract opportunities, you will need one to access additional capabilities—such as:

- Saving and rerunning searches
- Following opportunities to keep up to date on notices
- · Adding yourself to an opportunity's Interested Vendors List
- . Downloading search results or display items into .pdf or .csv files
- · Running customized reports on opportunities data
- Requesting access to controlled but unclassified attachments
