

Military Construction

- Overall program increasing
- Funding decisions are deferred until Ready to Advertise
- Several AF Projects pushed to FY22 and beyond

SRM Projects

- Mostly small business set-aside contracts
- Approximately 150 projects for \$200M in FY20
- Supporting more Navy tenants

Environmental

- ORC Contracts (Beale AFB, Hill AFB and March ARB and AZ/NV) AWARDED
- Total of 33 projects for \$100M in FY20








