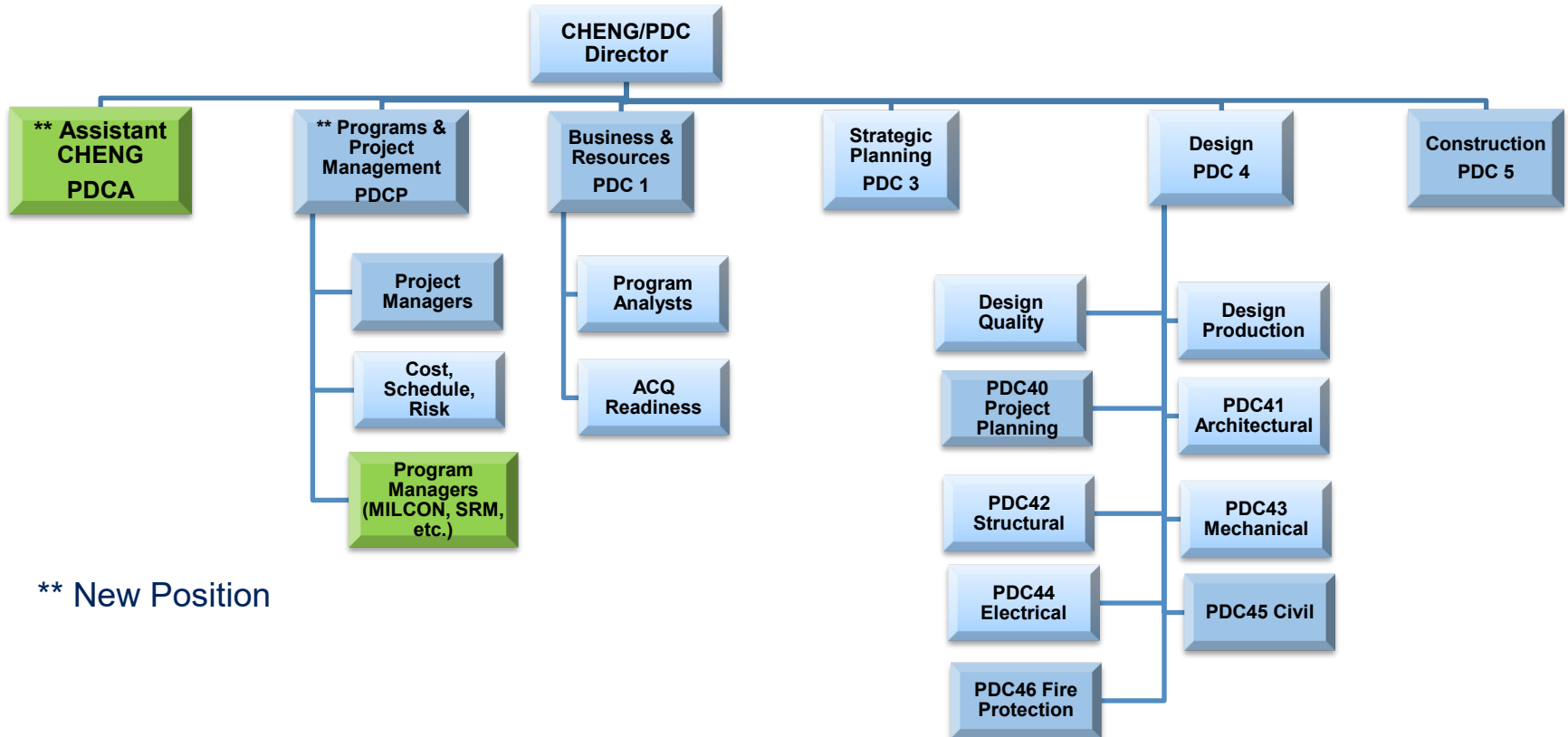

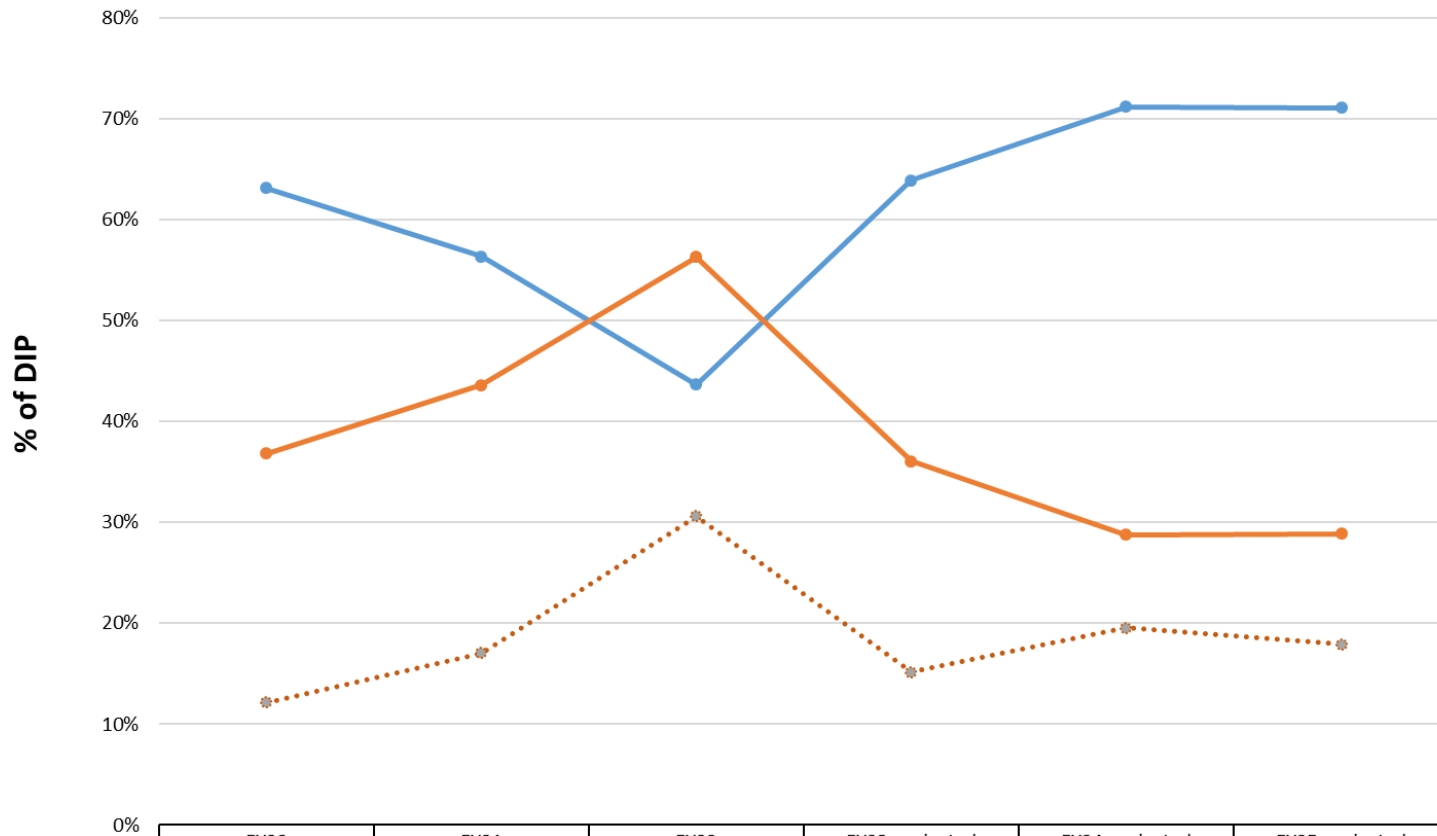

In House vs. AE Design Workload Projections

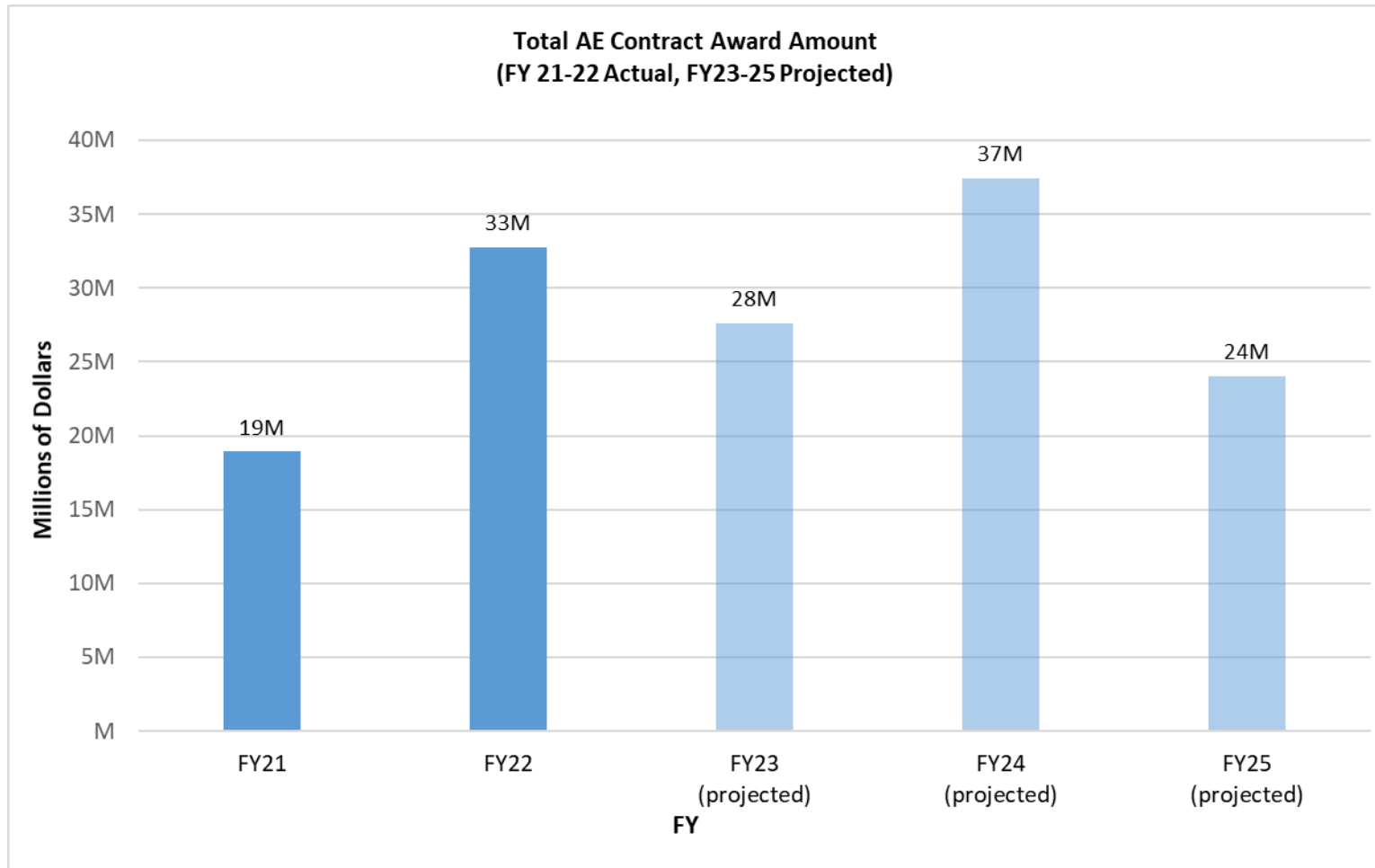


Percentage of AE and IH DIP

5 // Considerations For FY24



- **Due to projected increased workload, re-evaluate our bench of contracts**
 - Do we have the right mix of specialties and services?
 - Do the capacities and length of time match the needs?
 - Can we rely more on MACCs?
- **Focus on Cost Engineering support.**
 - Improved / increased accuracy
 - Expansion of cost / risk / analysis (CSRA) support during advanced planning & preliminary design. Required for projects +\$20M.
- **Gov't Shutdown**
 - Potential for November 2023

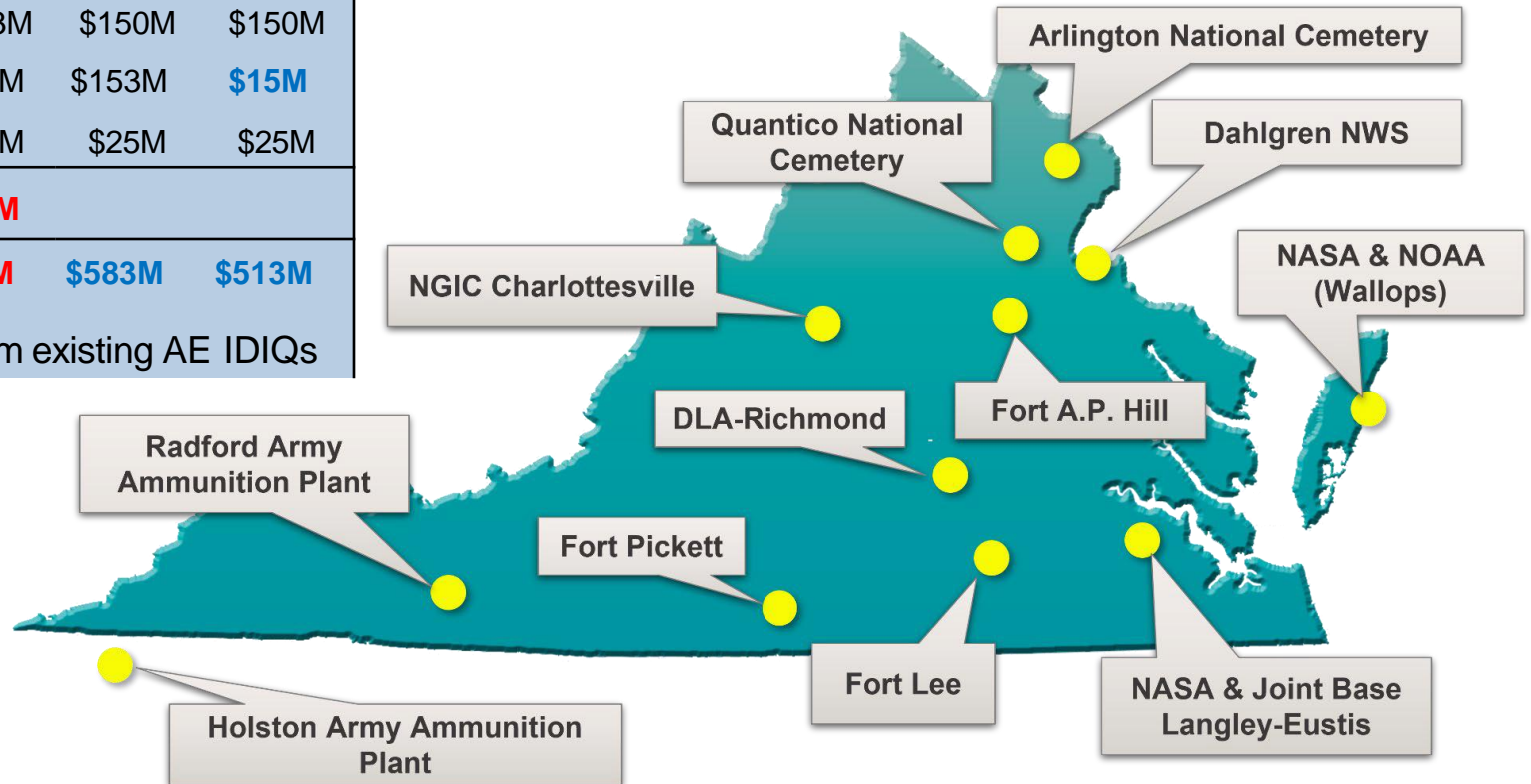

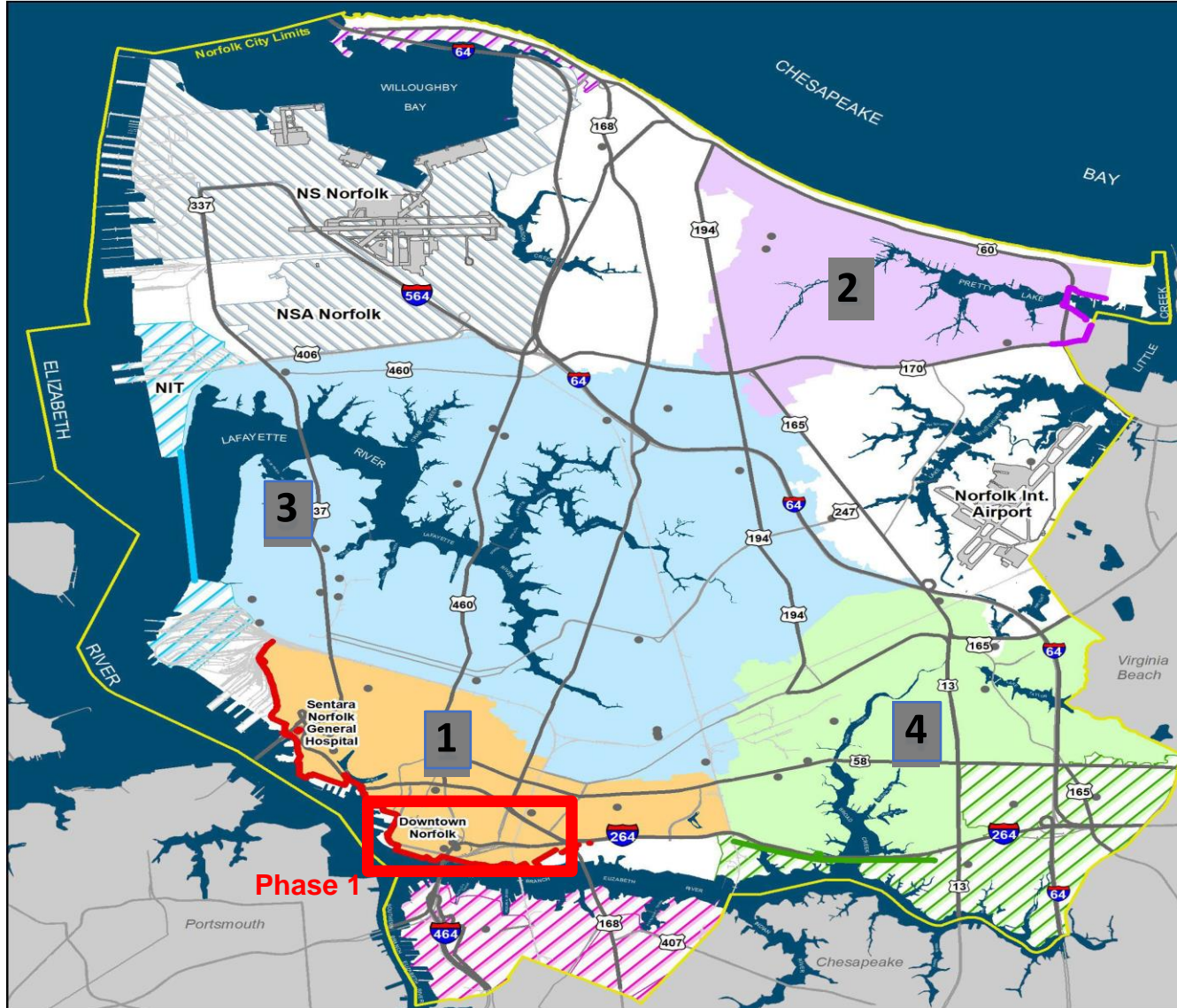

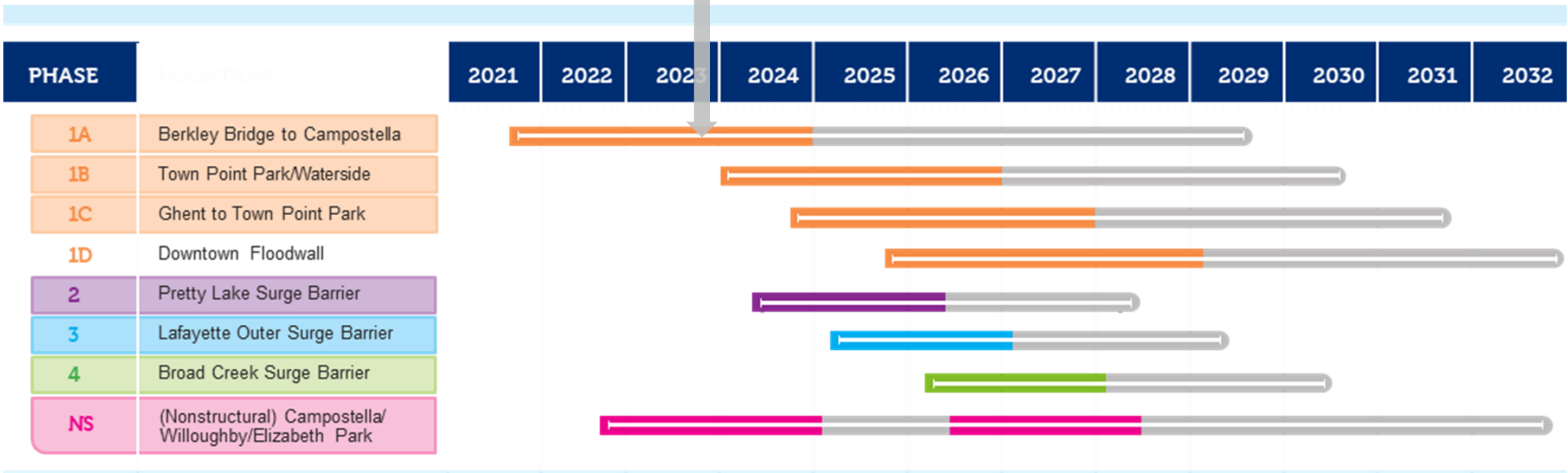

Design of Phase 1A = 65%, with 100% scheduled for January 2024

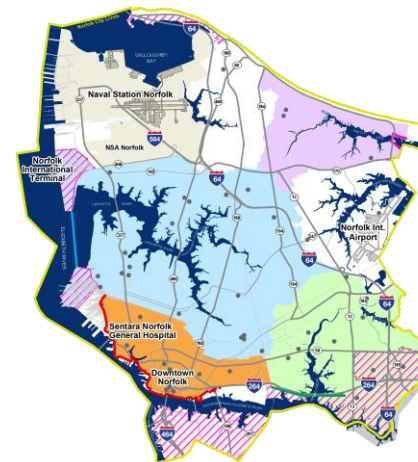

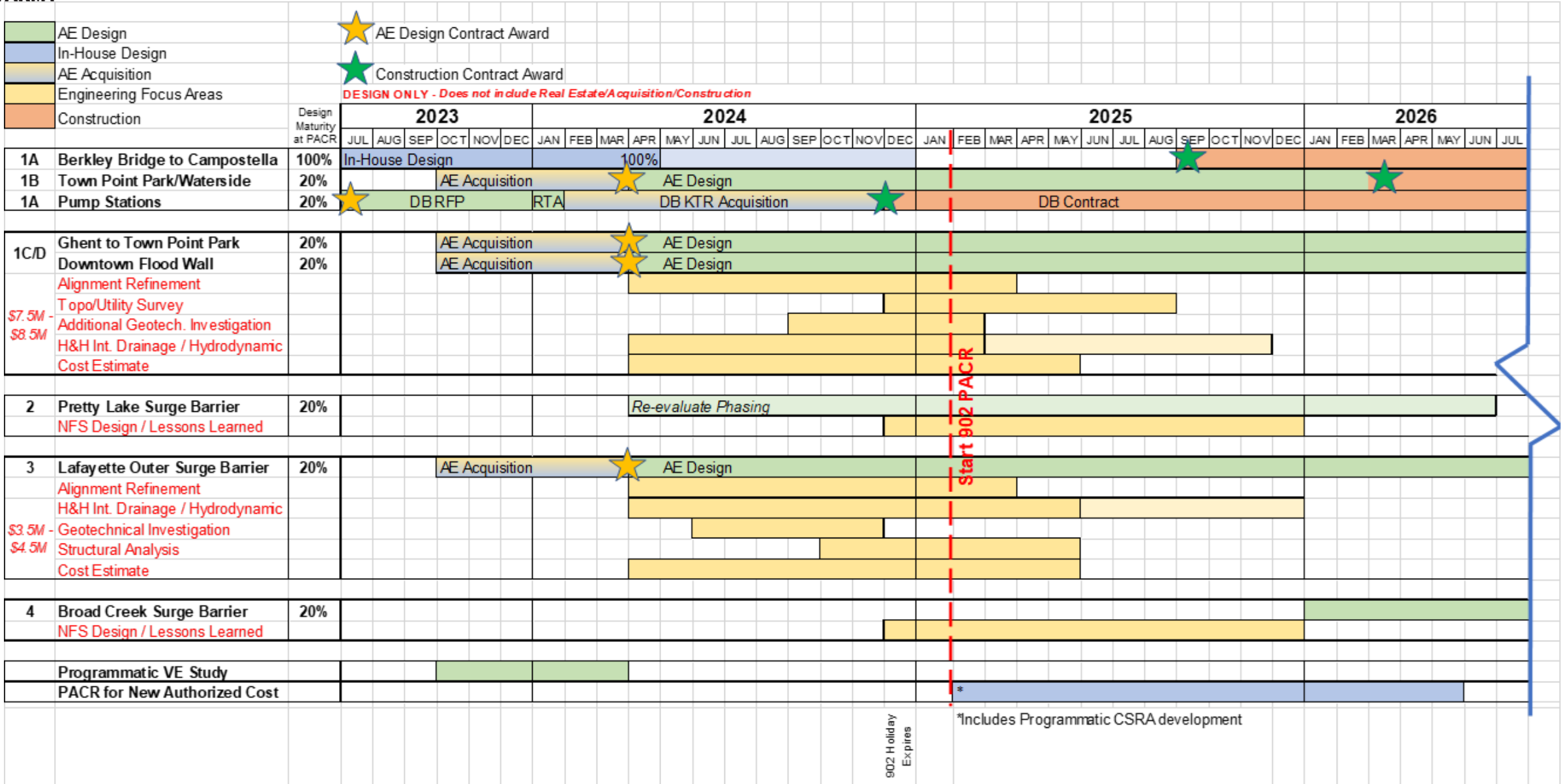




Schedule and Strategy for Construction and Cost Updates
