March 2022 Ground Up Partner Relationship, Culture and Capabilities

Speakers are Mike Lueck and Mark McCay

Abstract: This talk will cover USACE's current resources for Emergency Response and provide some understanding of the importance of upfront relationships and knowing your local infrastructure response culture and capabilities on a "Blue Sky Day" to help shape your expectations on the stormy days. Mike and Mark will share some tips on steps you can take for a more resilient recovery from the City and Federal levels.

March Speaker Biographies:

<u>Mike Lueck</u> - Over the last 18 years Mike has been the Emergency Services Coordinator for the City of Tigard with responsibilities for local jurisdictional emergency management operations, planning, coordinating and writing comprehensive emergency management plans which included continuity, response, recovery, mitigation, training and preparedness.

He also serves on city, county, regional and state level advisory committees and working groups, currently on the state Seismic Rehab Grant review Committee and the Disability Emergency Management Advisory Committee. He is an active incident command Overhead Team member for Tualatin Valley Fire and Rescue as the Logistic Section Chief.

Mike retired from active duty (Army) in 2000 with 23 years of Medical, Logistics and heavy Operational experience.

Mike has been a member of Oregon Emergency Management Association for 18 years holding the West Side Representative position and is a past Oregon Emergency Management Association President. Currently the Emergency Management Committee Chair for Oregon Chapter APWA.

<u>Mark McKay</u> - Mark is an emergency management professional with over 15 years of building skills and expertise in the areas of crisis response/Emergency Operations Center activations, risk mitigation, administration of crisis information/notification software systems, and project management. Action-oriented with strong ability to lead subject matter expert teams, communicate effectively with technology, executive, and public/private sector audiences.

He is currently responsible for Catastrophic Disaster Response Plan, COOP, EMAP accreditation, mobile Emergency Command and Control Vehicle (ECCV), and emergency communications for the USACE Portland District. Mark served in the US Navy for 8-years.
