


Protégé expands capacity to bid independently.

MPP Joint Ventures

JV Ownership & Work Performance Percentages

- Protégé firms must own at least 51% of the Joint Venture
- Protégé firms must perform at least 40%
 Mentor firms may perform up to 60%





Mentor-Protégé Joint Venture Basics



JV MAY RECEIVE UNLIMITED CONTRACTS IN TWO- YEAR PERIOD – NO MORE 3-IN-2 RULE



MENTORS CANNOT SUBMIT COMPETING OFFERS



JV MUST HAVE ITS OWN NAME, ITS OWN UEI, ITS OWN CAGE AND BE DESIGNATED IN SAM AS A JV ENTITY



FACILITY SECURITY CLEARANCES NOT REQUIRED FOR JV IF BOTH PARTNERS HAVE A SUCH CLEARANCE



NO JV APPROVAL FROM SBA, INCLUDING COMPETITIVE 8(A) JV



FACILITY SECURITY OFFICERS
MAY BE ADMINISTRATIVE
PERSONNEL




REQUIRED JV APPROVAL FROM SBA FOR 8(A) SOLE SOURCE JV



PROTÉGÉ MAY SUBSTITUTE MENTORS IF ITS CURRENT MENTOR IS NOT UPHOLDING THE AGREEMENT

Application Steps & Reporting Requirements

BE REGISTERED IN SAM

SELECT YOUR MENTOR

COMPLETE TRAINING CERTIFICATE & COMPOSE MPP AGREEMENT

APPLY THROUGH CERTIFY

ALLOW 105 DAYS

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- ✓ SUBMIT A CLEAN CASE
- ✓ CHECK YOUR INBOX & SPAM FOR INFO REQUESTS
- RESPOND QUICKLY

(15) days for screening

+

(90) days for processing



-- PROTEGES MUST:

Submit annual reports

Demonstrate material or developmental benefits

Submit annual and projectend reports & Certificates of Compliance for JVs

-- MENTORS MUST:

Provide meaningful assistance, as described in agreement



SBA RESERVES THE RIGHT TO:

Terminate the agreement for noncompliance if the mentor hasn't provided proper assistance
