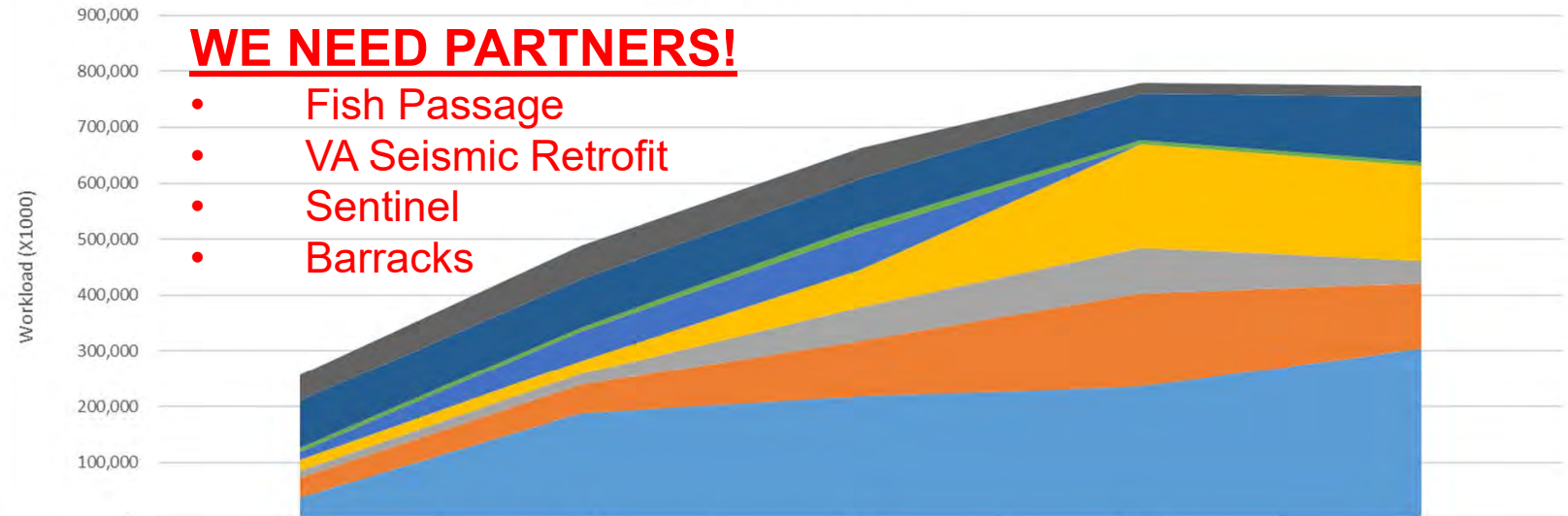

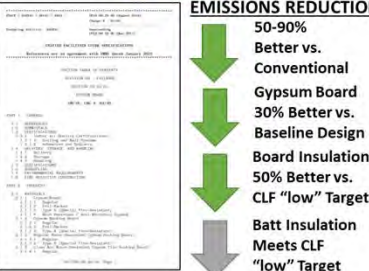
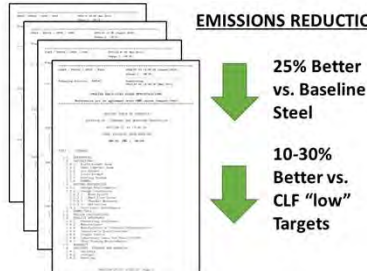
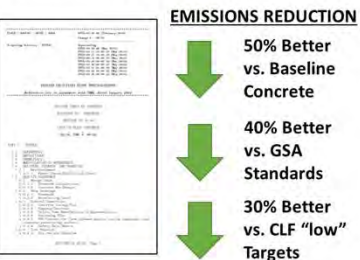
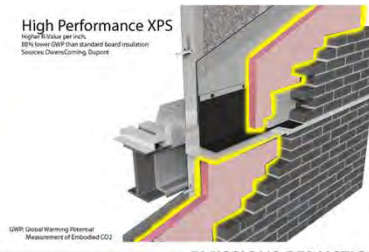
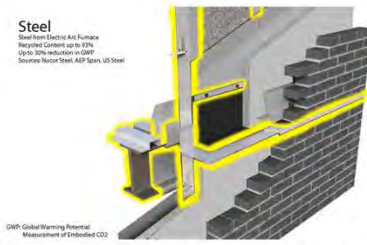
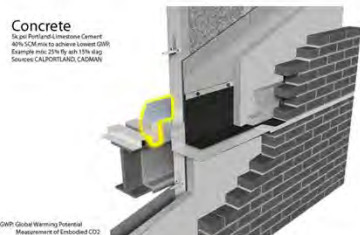
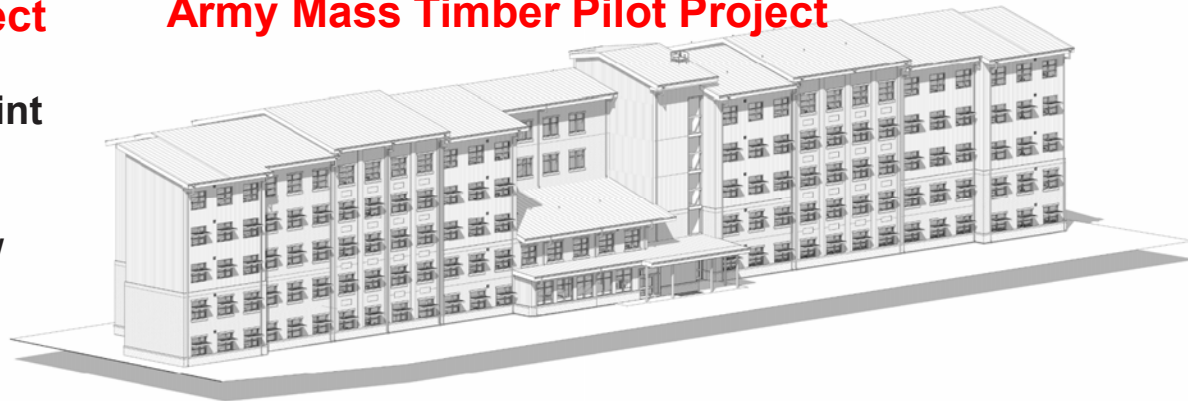
# BARRACKS PILOT PROJECTS

## Army Sustainable Materials Pilot Project

## Army Mass Timber Pilot Project

### Unaccompanied Personnel House (UEPH), Joint Base Lewis McChord Project:

- 168 soldiers via two new 3-story Barracks
- Sustainable material as “primary material” IAW NDA 2022 s.2861 requirements



### Features of Project:

- Accommodate up to 200 soldiers
- Maximum incorporation of Mass Timber in structural and architectural features (also 100% electrification)

### Current Activities for Mass Timber Pilot:

- 65% Design Complete Feb 2024
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Party/Partner providing general Mass Timber Design information and feedback/support via Q&A.
- Incorporated mass timber elements in structural and architectural features – design optimization underway
