





## **TOP TEN DO'S AND DON'TS**



- <u>**DO**</u> read the RFP and ask questions. When in doubt, ask. Double check before submitting proposals.
- **<u>DO</u>** your homework. Review fact sheets and know where your capabilities fit.
- **<u>DO</u>** respond to Sources Sought opportunities during market research phase. Update SAM regularly.
- **<u>DO</u>** sharpen your pencils Incumbents are not automatically the winners. Requirements change. Be ready.
- **DO** ask for a debrief This could impact your CPARS going forward.
- <u>**DO**</u> register with <u>SBO-HNC@usace.army.mil</u> and leverage the free services of the Small Business Office. Have a great relationship with your Procurement Center Representative (PCR).
- **DON'T** use blast e-mail hoping to reach the right person.
- <u>DON'T</u> overextend yourself. Do not take on work that you cannot do well. It could hurt you going forward in your CPARS.
- **DON'T** play with the math Do not plan to bid low and make it up using modifications.
- <u>DON'T</u> be afraid to leverage your Contracting Officer. Some customers want that which they didn't include in the scope. Your KO can help manage flawed expectations.
