Dear Counselor, Potential Applicant, or SAME Member,

The **Fort Bragg Post** of the Society of American Military Engineers (SAME) again has college scholarships it will award. The total scholarship fund for 2025 is estimated at **\$10,000.00**. Scholarships will be awarded to the most deserving applicants based on academic achievement, participation in extracurricular activities, and their desire to pursue an engineering or architectural degree in college.

The amount of the scholarship award will be based on the merits of the applicant. All awards are one-time awards. Past winners and past applicants that meet the eligibility requirements are welcome to apply again for the scholarship.

The applicant must submit a completed application (via email) by **April 18, 2025**. To be eligible for a scholarship, the applicant must meet the following requirements within an engineering or architectural-based curriculum:

- (1) Be a **high school senior residing in North Carolina or having graduated from a high school in North Carolina** who has been accepted, or is planning to enroll, at an accredited college or university,

OR

Be a **current undergraduate student** at an accredited college or university **in North Carolina** with a baccalaureate degree program,

OR

Be a **current undergraduate student at a North Carolina** technical community college with an associate degree program, after which the student plans to transfer to a four-year school with an engineering or architectural curriculum.

- (2) Have a **minimum** of a B average (3.0 on 4.0 scale), whether high school or college.
- (3) Provide a **completed application** form with **all** required supporting information.

After selections have been made, winning individuals will be contacted by the Scholarship Committee. The winners will be presented their scholarship checks at the **June 24, 2025** membership luncheon meeting of the Fort Bragg SAME Post.
