IDENTIFY THE AIR FORCE CONTRACTING ACTIVITY THAT PURCHASES YOUR PRODUCT OR SERVICE AND CONTACT THE SMALL BUSINESS SPECIALIST ON-SITE

- All Air Force Contracting activities are decentralized
- Each Contracting Office purchases supplies and services that support its own mission
- Each buying activity has a Small Business Specialist (http://www.airforcesmallbiz.af.mil/)
 home page: provides a list of small business specialists assigned to each buying activity



- Used by the Federal Government to purchase mission-essential supplies and services
- Authorized for "Appropriated Funds" only

\$10,000 RESTRICTION

Supplies and Equipment GPC is mandated for purchases
BELOW \$10,000

With Contracting Officer approval, occasionally purchases can be made up to \$2,500 on a pre-price vehicle such as GSA



\$2,500 PER TRANSACTION
