The Military Engineer (TME) magazine, January 1920:

"We are establishing at this time a Society of American Military
Engineers. This society will serve no selfish purpose. It is dedicated
to patriotism and national security. Its objects are, in brief, to promote
solidarity and co-operation between engineers in civil and military life,
to disseminate technical knowledge bearing upon progress in the art of
war and the application of engineering science thereto, and to preserve
and maintain the best standards and traditions of the profession, all in
the interests of patriotism and national security."






Mike Wehr Executive Director


- Philanthropic arm of the Society


