

**THE SOCIETY OF AMERICAN MILITARY ENGINEERS (SAME) OMAHA POST
STUDENT CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

Article I

1. Omaha Post Scholarships shall be offered annually each fall to SAME Student Chapter members.
2. Scholarship(s) awarded hereunder shall be in the amount of Two Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$2,000.00) and awarded to member(s) of Omaha SAME Post Student Chapters.
3. College students meeting the following criteria shall be eligible to apply for this scholarship:
 - a. Applications must be received on or before October 31.
 - b. Not currently Omaha Post SAME scholarship holder.
 - c. Candidate must be enrolled in a degree or certificate program at Metro Community College (MCC), University of Nebraska Lincoln (UNL) or University of Nebraska Omaha (UNO) and will be enrolling in the next term at their school.
 - d. The degree or certificate program must be in a science, technology, engineering, architecture, mathematics, construction, or related field.
 - e. Candidates shall have a 2.5 or higher cumulative GPA.
 - f. Candidates shall submit an essay (250-word maximum) discussing the contribution the applicant has made to the SAME Student Chapter (including list of involvement and attendance at events) and how their involvement in the Omaha SAME Student Chapter benefitted their academic experience.
4. All scholarships awarded hereunder shall be for one year and not renewable.

Article II

1. The recipient(s) of this scholarship shall be determined by the Scholarship Committee, which for the purposes of determining the recipient shall be composed of no less than three Omaha Post SAME members with no connections to the recipients.
2. The Omaha Post Board shall be kept apprised in a timely manner of the Scholarship Committee's activities.
3. This Scholarship shall be administered without regard to race, color, religion, age, gender, sexual orientation, national origin, or disability.
4. SAME reserves the right to increase or decrease this Scholarship.
5. If at any time, the Scholarship Committee determines that the purpose for which this Scholarship was established no longer exists, or cannot be reasonably carried out, the Scholarship Committee shall request the SAME Omaha Post Board to suspend the Scholarship.
6. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Scholarship may be amended or modified from time to time with the approval of the Omaha Post Board.
