POST 2025 ELECTION CANDIDATE CALL

The candidate call for our 2025 Post Elections is OPEN. There are five (5) positions available:

- 1. <u>2026 Vice President/2027 President-elect</u> This is a 2-year position. The individual elected will first serve as Vice President under **Sarah Fowlkes**, our previously elected 2026 President, then assumes the role of Post President for 2027. Following the individual's year as President, he/she will be asked to continue to serve as Past Post President on the 2028 Board.

 - Strategic Plan Goal 1, "Drive Partnerships", and its associated objectives and suggested Post Tasks see the 2030 Streamers Program.
 - Work with the Programs Director to arrange for speaker (s) for Post meetings and other events to help the Post achieve the Goal 1 Strategic Plan Post Tasks.
 - Assisting other elected Directors with partnership/industry-government engagement related objectives/ tasks within their assigned Goals.
 - Working with other elected Directors to ensure the Post accomplishes enough of the suggested Post Tasks related to the Strategic Plan to earn the Post Streamer annually.
- 5. <u>2026-27 Director</u>, <u>Member Development</u> This is a 2-year position. It is another of the 4 elected Directors (2 elected/re-elected each year) responsible for the 3 Goals in the <u>2030 SAME Strategic Plan</u>. This Director in conjunction with the Director for STEM & College Outreach and the help of other applicable Board/Committee members is overall responsible for:
 - Strategic Plan Goal 3, "Develop People", and its associated objectives and suggested Post Tasks see the <u>2030 Streamers Program</u>.
 - Assisting other elected Directors with member related objectives/tasks within their assigned Goals.
 - Working with other elected Directors to ensure the Post accomplishes enough of the suggested Post Tasks related to the Strategic Plan to earn the Post Streamer annually.

- Goal 3"Develop People"



The chart below shows the Post Board organization structure and how the elected positions fit in with the other appointed Board positions to support the **2030 SAME Strategic Plan**.



To be eligible to be a candidate for our elections, you MUST:

- 1. Be a SAME AND San Antonio Post individual member (see current rosters) AND
- 2. Not be a candidate for or an elected/appointed member of another Post's Board of Direction AND
- 3. If elected, keep your SAME and San Antonio Post membership current during your term

These positions do involve a commitment of time. There are Board meetings, Post meetings and work related to your specific activities/areas of responsibilities, which all together involve several hours each month. If you travel frequently as part of your job, it may hinder you from effectively filling a Board position.

All Post members should consider serving on the Post Board of Direction. We strongly encourage military and other public agency Post members to consider being candidates. The diversity and ideas from your job experience offer great opportunities to improve our operations and to make our activities more relevant to your respective organizations.

Lastly, let's continue to remember and support those in our communities impacted by this summer's flash floods. We must continue to learn from these tragedies, act, and reduce future risks.



CREDENTIALING **ASSISTANCE** PROGRAM (CAP)

FACT SHEET

OVERVIEW

The Credentialing Assistance Program (CAP) provides financial support for professional development, education, licensure and certification preparation, exam testing, and mentoring initiatives to benefit members. SAME will reimburse a portion of exam sitting or registration fees and the costs of testing preparation and training materials upon confirmation of passing an exam.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- This program is open to all SAME members, regardless of age.
- Applicants must be a SAME member for at least 12 months before applying.
- Applicants must have passed the respective examination and provide the required documentation with the application.
- The program covers financial assistance for exam sitting fees, registration fees, and study expenses (such as books or classes for the specific exam).

APPROVED A/E/C CREDENTIALS

- Certified Construction Manager (CCM)
- Certified Energy Manager (CEM)
- Certified Facility Manager (CFM)
- Certified Professional Services Marketer
- Design Build Institute of America (DBIA)
- Facility Management Professional (FMP)
- Leadership In Energy and Environmental Design (LEED)
- National Institute for Certification in Engineering Technologies (NICET)
- Professional Engineer (PE)
- Project Management Professional (PMP)
- Registered Architect (RA)

PROGRAM RESTRICTIONS

No single government official or employee, or private sector individual shall receive more than \$500 in assistance through the SAME CAP program. Individuals will remain eligible to receive reimbursement through other SAME programs.



CREDENTIALING REVIEW COURSE (CRC)

PROGRAM SHEET

OVERVIEW

The Credentialing Review Course (CRC) is a valuable benefit that provides SAME members with free access to credentialing review courses to help prepare them for professional certification exam testing.

REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must demonstrate active engagement or participation at the Post, Regional, or National level, and receive an endorsement from a Post President, Fellow, or National Board of
- Applicants must be active, paid SAME members for at least 12 months. Student memberships do not count toward this period
- The member must provide proof of registration for their respective exam within 30 days of receiving access to the review courses through PP(2Pass (for FE, PE, and ARE credentials). The exam should be scheduled within three- to nine-months of the award.
- Applicant must be willing to engage with a mentor from SAME (monthly at a minimum). throughout the time enrolled in the review course.
- Members selected for the CRC (or SAME Credentialing Assistance Program) will remain eligible to receive benefits from the other credentialing support program, no matter what order they apply to receive benefits.

ON-DEMAND CREDENTIALING REVIEW COURSES

The following professional licensure exams are available through the PPI2Pass:

- Fundamentals of Engineering Exam (All included)
- Professional Engineer Exam (All included)
- Architect Registration Examination (PcM, PM, PA, PPD, PDD, CE)

PROGRAM PARTICIPATION ACCOUNTABILITY

- Once an applicant is granted a seat in the CRC, they will have access for 12 months.
- Recipients will be assigned a mentor or they may request an established SAME member to serve as their mentor.
- Participants are to monitor overall progress based on the initial plan they establish with their mentor (and provide a schedule to the mentor to ensure the plan is being met).
- Participants will receive a warning if they fail to maintain the planned progress over the initial eight-week period.
- Should there be no improvement in the subsequent four weeks, the committee will assess the situation for additional action.

DOD Updates

Air Force Chief of Staff Announces Retirement

(AF CE Weekly Email Aug 26, Story by Air Force Public Affairs)

ARLINGTON, Va. (AFNS) -- The 23rd U.S. Air Force Chief of Staff Gen. David Allvin announced plans today to

retire effective on or about Nov. 1, 2025. He has served as the Chief of Staff since Nov. 2, 2023, and prior to that as the Air Force Vice Chief of Staff since November 2020. Allvin is an Air Force Academy graduate and command pilot with over 4,600 flying hours who has led with distinction throughout his 39-year career. He will continue to serve as Chief of Staff until a replacement is confirmed which will allow time for a smooth leadership transition. A formal retirement ceremony with full honors will occur later this fall.

"I'm grateful for the opportunity to serve as the 23rd Air Force Chief of Staff and I'm thankful for Secretary Meink, Secretary Hegseth and President Trump's faith in me to lead our service," Allvin said. "More than anything, I'm proud to have been part of the team of Airmen who live out our core values of integrity, service and excellence every day as we prepare to defend this great nation."

"The Air Force is fortunate to have leaders like General Dave Allvin. During his tenure, the Air Force has undertaken transformational initiatives that will enable Airmen to answer their nation's call for decades to come," Secretary of the Air Force Troy E. Meink said. "General Allvin has been instrumental in my onboarding as the



department's 27th Secretary and I'm forever grateful for his partnership as well as his decades of exemplary service to our nation."


