 - Compilation of rates is complete (received 19 May). Negotiations in progress.






Acquisition Planning Forecast System:

Proposed Infrastructure for New Campus



 - Proposals Due 17 October 2025







Overview of Facilities & Functions

Engineering Support Building

- 90,000 GSF Facility
- Facilities Engineering (FE) Responsible for the day-to-day operation, maintenance and repair of CG facilities. Provides environmental compliance support.
- Electronics Support Detachment (ESD) Provides technical support, maintenance, and repair services for electronic systems used by CG units.
- Maintenance & Weapons Detachments Provides specialized technical support to field units to enhance asset readiness and operation performance to include troubleshooting and repairs, training and guidance, preventative maintenance and system upgrades.
- Industrial Production Facility (IPF) Performs depot-level maintenance.
 Handles complex repairs, fabricates parts, implements system upgrades, and offers technical and logistical support to ensure assets remain mission ready.
- Boat Maintenance Facility Perform routine and complex repairs, preventative maintenance, and overhauls on CG small boats.
- HAZMAT Pharmacy Responsible for the inventory management, compliance, training and support, and safety oversight of hazardous materials used by CG units.
- Anticipated solicitation date of FY27

<u>Multifunctional Building - Unaccompanied Personnel Housing (UPH),</u> <u>Galley, Fitness Center, Exchange</u>

- 120,000 GSF Facility
- Minimum 75-Room UPH facility that provides safe, affordable, and convenient living accommodations for CG members without dependents, typically junior enlisted personnel.
- Culinary Support Activity that is capable of meal planning and preparation, inventory management of food supplies, training and guidance to culinary specialists, and providing food service capabilities during deployments, emergencies and extended missions. The feeding mission is 401- 650 people.
- CG Exchange retail store system operated by the CG to provide goods and services to CG personnel, their families, retirees and authorized patrons.
- Fitness facility that integrates weight-lifting and cardio equipment, fitness classroom space, and shower and locker rooms
- Anticipated solicitation date of FY27





Overview of Facilities & Functions (contd.)





Pier Mike

- Approximately 1,100 LF in length
- Demolish existing and construct new pier to support 5 major cutters (OPCs with flexibility to accommodate WMSLs)
- Replace bulkhead (adjacent to Piers Mike & Papa)
- Dredging
- Anticipated solicitation date of FY26

Shipping & Receiving Facility

- 15,000 GSF
- Facility plays a critical role in the logistical operations of the Base and its tenant units
- Functions include receipt and shipping of goods, inventory management, logistics coordination, and support for operational readiness
- Includes a centralized recycling area
- Anticipated solicitation date of FY28/29





Overview of Facilities & Functions (contd.)





Parking Solution

- Maximizes parking for approximately 300 personal vehicles
- Provides vertical and horizontal solutions to provide sufficient parking for homeported personnel and protection for deployed crewmembers during flooding events
- Anticipated solicitation date of FY28/29

Stormwater Management System

- Perform a comprehensive assessment of existing the stormwater system
- Integrate requirements for future growth
- Develop corrective actions
- Modify existing system to deliver a campus-wide stormwater management system
- Anticipated solicitation date of FY28/29





Small Arms Firing Range (SAFR)/Armory

- A facility designed to support firearms training and qualification for Coast Guard personnel
- Functions include firearms training, weapons qualification, tactical training, safety and compliance, equipment testing, and readiness support
- Project includes enclosed firing lanes, firearms maintenance shops, and classrooms
- Anticipated solicitation date of FY29+

Recapitalize Pier Papa

- Approximately 1,100 LF in length
- Demolish existing and construct new pier to support 5 major cutters (OPCs with flexibility to accommodate WMSLs)
- Dredging
- Anticipated solicitation date of FY29+



Overview of Facilities & Functions (contd.)





Sector Building

- 28,000 GSF
- Responsible for maritime safety, security, and environmental stewardship for the Charleston area of responsibility (AOR)
- Administrative and support spaces for Sector personnel
- Provides a Sector Command Center, which serves as the operational hub for coordinating and managing maritime missions within the Charleston AOR
- Anticipated solicitation date of FY29+





In-progress Projects: Recapitalize Pier Novem Berguard



Recapitalize Pier November

- Design-Build contract awarded to the Whiting-Turner Contracting Company in July 2022 for \$112M.
- Scope: demolish old pier, construct new 1,190' x 82' pier to support 5 National Security Cutters, repair collapsed bulkhead, dredging, and minor shore side improvements for utilities
- Mobilized January 2024
- Estimated completion fall 2026





Base Admin Building

- Design-Build contract awarded to the RQ-AECOM JV June 2023 for \$52M.
- Scope: construct 50K gross sq. ft. building to support Base admin, training, procurement, and Command functions.
- Mobilized August 2024
- Estimated completion fall 2026
