Scholarship Application Instructions

A. Scholarship Eligibility

High school seniors and current college students from the New England area must plan to study architecture, engineering, construction, computer science, or related STEM fields. Students who plan to pursue a trade school are also eligible to apply.

B. Selection

1. A board of SAME officers will make the selection.
2. Selection will be based on academic achievement, character, personal merit, and commitment towards the field of engineering. Merit is demonstrated through leadership in school, civic and extracurricular activities, academic achievement, and motivation to serve and succeed.
3. Selection will be made with no regard to race, color, creed, sex, or national origin.

C. Instructions

1. Application will be typed. A signature is required on the application. Print the application, sign it, scan it, and submit it electronically or sign it electronically.
2. Applications must include current transcripts (unofficial transcripts are acceptable).
3. Applications must be submitted electronically, preferably as one document.
4. Completed applications must be emailed by 1600 on 1 May 2026. The committee will not consider incomplete applications or those received after May 1, 2026.
