

AFIMSC Forward

AFIMSC Det 4 CEL Mission Overview

Mission - Provide centralized design and construction management and execution support for United States Visit Forces (USVF) Military Construction (MILCON) and Unspecified Minor Military Construction (UMMC) projects

- DoDD 4270.5 / AFI 32-1023 designates the Department of the Air Force (AFIMSC Det 4/CEL – AFCEC Operating Location) as the DoD Construction Agent (DCA) for the British Isles
 - This designation assigns AFIMSC Det 4/CEL the same responsibilities as USACE and NAVFAC.
- Construction historically executed through UK Ministry of Defence (MoD) via Defence Infrastructure Organisation (DIO) in accordance with 1951 SOFA / 1973 Cost Sharing Arrangement
- \$4.2B current program value, projects in planning, design and construction, \$1.3B in Draft status
- Bilateral Defense Forum (BDF) stood up to identify and implement needed modifications and updates to existing policy and procedures for US-UK Defense activities to include development of Implementing Agreements for multiple considerations such as security agreements and construction execution
- Det 4/CEL Office restructure in process to better support MILCON and NSIP execution in the UK
