




CMMC: An Overview

The Cybersecurity Maturity Model Certification (CMMC) program mandates that all organizations handling Federal Contract Information (FCI) or Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI) maintain specific cybersecurity maturity levels to protect sensitive data.

What it is: A cybersecurity certification now required for all Department of War (DoW) contractors.

The Goal: To protect sensitive government information.

The Bottom Line: When CMMC applies, you must prove your computer systems are secure to win a contract.



The CMMC Rollout & How It Affects You

A Phased Rollout on Purpose

- CMMC is introduced over years.
- This gives everyone companies time to prepare.
- The goal is to reduce the burden, especially for small businesses.

How You'll Know CMMC Applies

- It only applies if it's explicitly required in the contract solicitation.
- Look for the DFARS clause 252.204-7021 in the document.

What to Expect Now

- The first year is focused on self-certifications.
- When CMMC is identified in the solicitation, before awarding a contract the Contracting Officer will verify your CMMC level in the SPRS database.

2. Register in SPRS: <https://piee.eb.mil/>

- **Register in PIEE:** Create your company and user accounts within the PIEE portal.
- **Request SPRS Access:** Obtain the necessary roles within PIEE to access the Supplier Performance Risk System (SPRS) module.
- **Log In and Post Scores:** Use PIEE as the gateway to SPRS, where you will post your current cybersecurity self-assessment scores, including NIST SP 800-171.




- **UFC Equivalencies, Waivers, Exemptions Considered Favorably**
