


(U) A few troops and a few dollars go a long way on a continent 3.5 times the size of the U.S.


(U) ~5,500 troops (<.3% of USMIL) + \$2.1B total authority (~.3% of DoD budget)...**USG & DoD can afford it!**



Theater Logistics Overview

J4 Lines of Effort

1. Crisis Response – “The No Fail Mission.”


- 16 Posture Locations positioned for multiple missions.
- Crisis response synchronization and integration of partnered support.
- Coordination of airlift, distribution, and deployment.
- Commercial contracted support capability and vendor threat mitigation.

3. Leveraging logistics through partnership and engagements for security cooperation.

- The Theater Logistics Readiness Program (TLRP) consists of 3 Lines of Effort focused on building partner capacity in West Africa and then scaling:
 - Build a Senior African Logistics Leader Network
 - Develop and enhance logistics education and exercises
 - Assess, Advise, Advocate and Integrate (A3I) program
