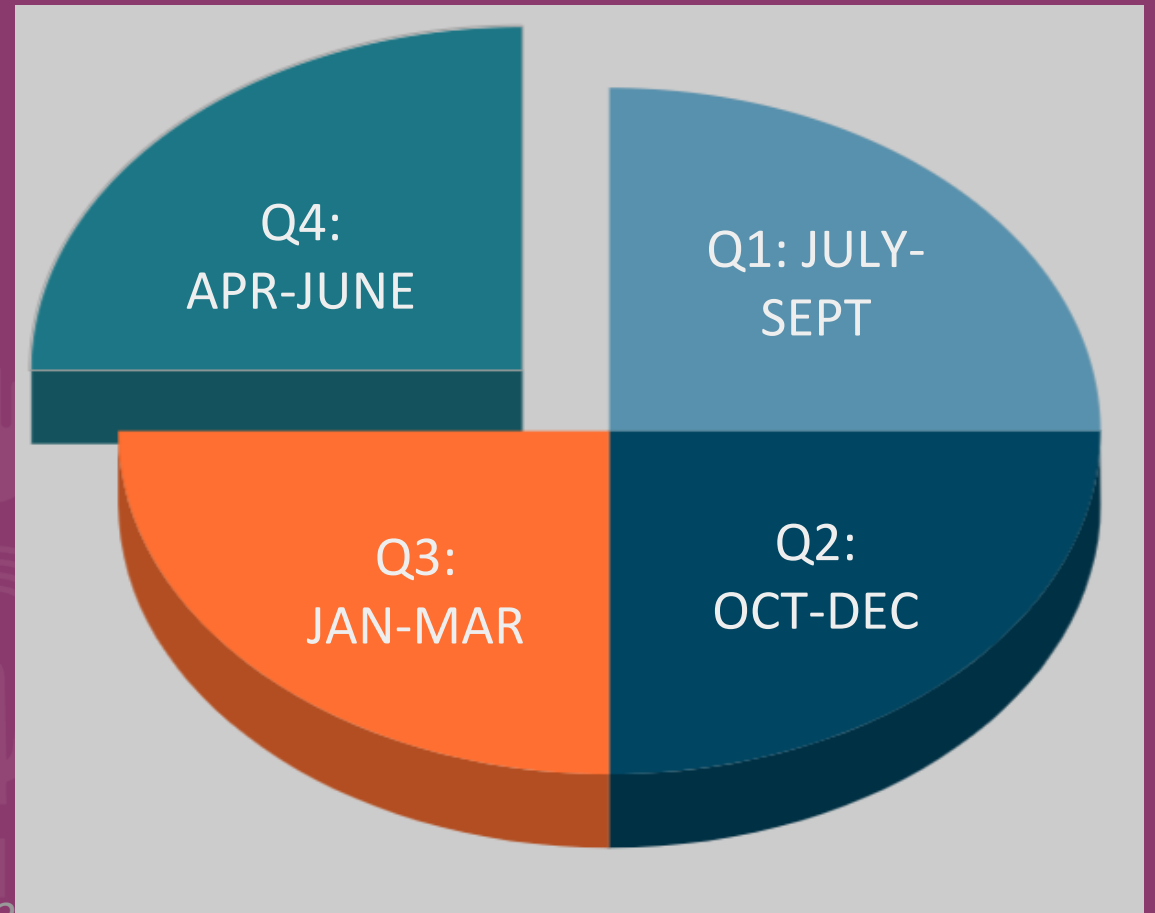



If Bids are 15% UNDER or 10% OVER the Department's Estimate a Justification Letter is needed.

C&S Specialist discusses difference in pricing with the low bid contractor

Usually, projects that open in a given month will be awarded at the next month's State Transportation Board (STB) meeting. STB meetings are the 3rd Friday of each month

**Award Letters** issued within 2 Days of STB

## Executing the Contract (Section 103.08)

**10 Calendar Days:** Contractor has **10 calendar days** after award to return signed contract, insurance & bonds

**20 Calendar Days:** Department has **20 calendar days** after award date to execute the contract
