Nebraska Task Force 1 is one of 28 Urban Search & Rescue (US&R) task forces in the national disaster response system under the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). NE-TF1 was established in 1993 with Lincoln Fire & Rescue Department as the sponsoring agency. US&R is a multi-hazard discipline that may be needed for a variety of emergencies or disasters. These include earthquakes, hurricanes, typhoons, severe storms and tornadoes, floods, dam failures, technological accidents, terrorist activities, structural collapse and hazardous materials release. Ms. Engler provided an overview of NE-TF-1’s capabilities, and future plans.
