What is OKVR?

okveteransresources.com is a free online directory that connects Oklahoma veterans, service members, and their families to verified help: local resources, veteran-owned businesses, and employers who hire veterans.



Built by a veteran nonprofit

The Eagle OPS Foundation runs it. Nothing to buy, no login required, no ads.



Every listing is reviewed

A real person checks each submission before it publishes, and we confirm listings stay active over time.



Made for the whole state

Search, categories, and an interactive 77-county map cover every corner of Oklahoma.

Statewide veteran events, powered by okveteranscalendar.com.

A clean path to work: OKJobMatch, one-on-one help from OKVetWorks, then verified employers.

25 Oklahoma and federal benefits matched to a veteran's VA rating, county by county.

Why post your organization?



Be found statewide

Veterans, families, and case workers search by county and category. If you are not listed, you are invisible to that search.



Verified builds trust

Nothing publishes without review, and we confirm listings stay active. Being on OKVR means a veteran never calls a dead number.



Easy to share

Every filtered search has its own link. An advocate can text a veteran the exact list of help they need.



Neutral ground

OKVR champions every organization that helps veterans. No memberships, no favorites, no fine print.

Why it matters

Eagle OPS works upstream of the crisis. Connection to community, and to the right resource at the right time, is what keeps veterans with us. When the first call works, trust is built and the next step gets easier. That is what this directory is for, and it is why every listing matters.

Who should post?



Nonprofits & VSOs

Peer groups, service officers, and outreach programs.



Government agencies

State, county, tribal, and federal veteran programs.



Veteran-owned businesses

Every industry. Certification is not required.



Employers who hire veterans

Companies with proof behind the promise.



Faith & community groups

Churches and civic groups with veteran programs.



Education & training

Schools, GI Bill programs, trades, and certifications.



Housing, legal & financial

Shelter, legal aid, claims help, and money coaching.



Health & wellness

Care for body and mind, from clinics to peer support.

Fill out the short form. No account, no login, no cost.

We review and verify

A team member checks every submission before anything publishes.

3

You go live

Your listing appears statewide, and we check in over time to keep it current.

Make your listing count



A phone number and email a veteran can actually reach.



A plain-language description of who you serve and what you do.



Your coverage area, whether it is one county or all 77.



A quick click when our “still active?” email lands in your inbox.



How we keep it clean

Every listing gets a one-click confirmation email from time to time. If we cannot confirm an organization is still active after four weeks, we quietly hide the listing until we hear back.

It is nothing personal. It is how we make sure every number a veteran calls gets answered.
